

Constitution and by-laws of
The Woman's Institute of Saltfleet.
Adopted at the first meeting at Stony Creek,
February 25th, 1897.

I The name of the Institute shall be
The Woman's Institute of Saltfleet.

II The object of this Institute shall be, to promote the
knowledge of Household Science which shall lead
to improvement in household architecture with
special attention to home sanitation, to a better
standing of the economic and hygienic value of
foods and fuels, and to a more scientific care
of children with a view of raising the general standard
of the health of our people.

III Memberships in this Institute is open to all women
who will take an active interest in the welfare
of the Woman's Institute of Saltfleet and pay the
fee 25 c. (Those joining before June will be
considered in good standing for the year ending
June 30th, 1898.)
