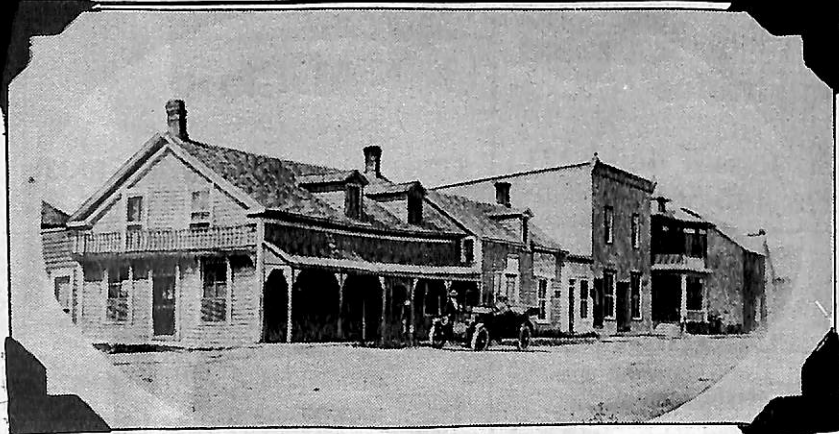


Russell Reflections
