

Stony Creek April 12/1917

The regular meeting of the Society was held on the above date in the Parish Hall, the President in the chair. The meeting opened in the usual way by all repeating the Lord's Prayer, after which the minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

The report of the work done for the month for the Red Cross was given, a letter was read from Mrs. Dyakis, Secy of the Women's Tribute Fight in aid of Great-War Veterans, asking for a tribute to be given in aid of an entertainment to be held on April 23 at the Armories. After a short discussion it was moved by Mrs. Rogers and by Mrs. E. Jones that we donate \$10.

A petition from the Dominion Alliance, for War Time Prohibition was brought before the meeting asking that an act prohibiting the manufacture in, and the transportation into, the Dominion of Canada of Intoxicating liquors, be passed. A vote was taken and was in favour of signing the petition.

Mrs. Rogers, S. York and Mr. Hopkins were appointed to collect and buy a present for Mrs. Davis in behalf of the Society. The following programme was given:
