Donations during this meeting were 12.50, amt. collected <sup>all together being \$35.00</sup>

The War Charities Act was again discussed in full. It was moved by Mrs. Beaumont. Sec. by Mrs. Millard that the signing of the War Charities Act be left to the Executive. The meeting closed with God Save the King.

The jam was made at the factory of E. & Smith and processed free of charge by this firm, the bill being sent to us for sugar and fruit only. This was in co-operation with Saltfleet & Wisconsin Institutes, the total amt. of jam made being nearly 1000 lbs.
