Constitution and By-laws of The Womans Institute of Saltfleetaadopted at the First Meeting at Stoney Creek February 25 - 1897. The name of the Institute shall be The Woman's Institute of I. Saltfleet. 2/ The object of this Institute shall be, to promote that knowledge of Household Science which shall lead to improvement in Household Architecture, with special attention to Home Sanitation, to a better understanding of the Economic and Hygienic value of Foods and Fuels and to a more scientific care of children, with a view of raising the general health of our people. Membershop This Institute is open to all Women who will take an 3. active interest in the welfare of the Woman's Institute of Saltfleet, and pay the annual fee of Twenty-five cents. Those joining before June will be considered in good standing for the year ending June 30-1898. The Officers shall consist of Honorary President, President 4. Ist Vice President and 2nd Vice President, Secretart, Treasurer. and three(3) Directors, who with the officers above named shall constitute the Board of Directors. 5. The Executive Committee shall consist of President. Vice President and Secretary. The Annual Meeting shall be held on the Ist Thursday on June and 6. at such place as the Board of Directors shall decide. Other meetings shall be held at such place as the majority of members shall decide at each previous meeting. 7. The Officers shall be elected by ballot of members after nomination. For the better carrying out of the object of the Institute it shall be divided into six (6) divisions or branches as follows. 8. I. Domestic Economy. 2. Architecture, with special reference to Sanitation, Light, Heat etc. 3. Physiology, Hygiene. Medicine, Calisthenics etc. 4. Floriculture, Horticulture. 5. Music and Art. 6. Literature and Sociology, Education, Legislation. Vacancies caused by death or resignation shall be filled at the next regular meeting. This Constitution can be Altered or Ammended by a two-thirds vote of IO. the members present at the Annual Meeting, or at any regular meeting provided that notice of the proposed amendment has been given at the last regular meeting, but members absent from the meeting must be notified of the proper amendment. By - Laws Adopted st the first regilar meeting on February 25/1897 at Stoney Creek. The Management of the Institute shall be vested in the Board of Directors of which five (5) shall constitute a quorum for a regular meeting two (2) members of the executive shall constitute a quorum thereof. 2. The
