

He has been honoured on several occasions as quest conductor at several University music clinics in the United States of America. In the field of Broadway Productions, he has conducted "South acific", "Brigadoon" and "Carousel" for the Hamilton Theatre Inc.

Mr. Houslander has been Director of Music for the past four years at Saltfleet District High School.
