Vera Lawrence was born on June 1, 1906, at Corsham Wiltshire England. Her parents Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence immigrated to Canada with their family in 1912 and settled in Hamilton, Ontario. She has one sister, now Mrs. Annie Ball, living in England.
