



"Mrs. Adelaide Hunter Hoodless."

The Adelaide Hunter Hoodless Homestead is situated in South Dumfries Township, Brant County. A half mile from the Homestead is a cairn in a small landscaped park set aside by the Ontario Department of Highways as a reserve in perpetuity for the memorial, at the Highway junction 5 and 24.

The inscription on the memorial plaque reads:

Adelaide Hunter Hoodless

1857 - 1910

Who founded the Women's Institutes on February 19th 1877
Erected by the Women's Institutes of Brant County. Unveiled by 1973

Her Excellency The Lady Tweedsmuir October 20th 1937
