Through the efforts of the House of Lenthric and Yardley of London, the village of Tweed has received a letter from the Queen Mother, congratulating the village on its centennial.

The letter was received in Tweed last week, and after a copy was made to donate to the Tweed and Area Historical Society, it was suitably framed and will be on display in the municipal building.

The letter reads:

"Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother has learned with interest

that the Town of Tweed will be celebrating its Centenary between the 29th June and 1st July.

The Queen Mother, who has such a warm relationship with the Province of Ontario, asks me to convey to you and to the citizens of Tweed Her Majesty's greetings and sincere good wishes on such an important occasion."

The letter was addressed to the Reeve, and signed by the Private Secretary to Queen Elizabeth, The Queen Mother. The House of Lenthric controls Tweed Perfume, of which the Queen Mother is patron.
