



SIGNALLER ROSCOE ROBSON - a third son of Mr. & Mrs. Lewis Robson - also born at Moira, Dec. 6, 1897 - Graduated from Belleville High School with Junior Matriculation and Normal entrance in 1915. Graduated from Madoc Model School in Dec. 1915 - taught at S.S. No. 22 Tyendinaga from Jan. 2, 1916 - Dec. 22, 1917. Enlisted in the 73 Battery Kingston May 3, 1918 - went overseas in June, 1918. Attended school of Gunnery at Borden, England from Aug. to Dec. 1918 from which he graduated as a seige signaller. Returned to Canada July 7, 1919 - Farmed on the 9th Concession of Thurlow. May 19, 1923, he married Eva Mae Hodgen of Plainfield, daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Ernest Hodgen - children Audrey, Shirley, Barbara, John and Rodger. Entered Thurlow Township Council Jan. 1932, as a Councillor - Deputy Reeve 1935 - 1938.- Reeve, 1938 - 1943. Elected to Ontario Legislature Aug. 7, 1943, for the Constituency of East Hastings - re-elected in 1945 and 1948 as a Progressive Conservative. He had enlisted in the Reserve Army at Madoc on July 11, 1940. Received commission as 2nd Lieutenant in 1941 - discharged in 1943 as physically unfit.
