

BOMBARDIER JOHN JOSEPH ROBSON: Born Sept. 15, 1893 at Moira -
1st Concession Huntingdon, son of Mr. & Mrs. Lewis Robson -
Graduated from Ontario Business College 1909. Entered the
firm of Robson, Ritchie and Hill accountants in Montreal
in Sept. 1909. Enlisted in Montreal on March 12, 1916,
in the 66th Battery of the Canadian Field Artillery - went
overseas in Aug. 1916 and to France in July, 1917 with the
4th Division - killed in action Sept. 27, 1918 at the Battle
of Cambria in France.



SERGEANT PETER WILLIAM ROBSON: Born Aug. 4, 1895 at Moira
1st Concession of Huntingdon - son of Mr. & Mrs. Lewis Robson.
Graduated from Ontario Business College in 1911. Farmed
at home until Dec. 1915 when he enlisted in the 155th
Battalion of the Canadian Expeditionary Force. Went
overseas in Sept. 1916 - went to France in April, 1917
with the 21st Battalion - was killed 10 days later in
action, May 3, 1917 at Fresnoy, France.
