

of this Club.

Section 3.- Charges preferred against a member of the Club must be submitted to the President in writing specifying the offence and must be signed by a member of good standing.

Section 4.- When charges have been preferred they shall be referred to a committee of three disinterested members for investigation who shall proceed to try the case.

Section 5.- Every member shall be entitled to a fair and impartial trial for any offence except non-payment of dues.

Section 6.-The committee of three shall be authorized to select a Secretary who shall keep correct record of the trial.

Section 7.- The committee shall have power to summons all witnesses.

Section 8.- The penalty in all trials shall be limited to expulsion for 30 days or expulsion indefinitely.

Section 9.- All members summoned as witnesses for a trial shall appear upon notice or be expelled for 30 days.

Article VIII.

All members in good standing shall be entitled to participate in all entertainments, socials, games, etc.
