PREAMBLE

For the purpose of uniting the boys and girls of the community and elevating their social, moral and intellectual standing and the promotion of their general welfare, the B. & Z. A. Club has been organized.

ARTICLE I.

This organization shall be known as B. & Z. A. Club.

ARTICLE II.

Sec. I.—Any applicant of the B. & Z. A. Club must be upright, honest and of good standing in their community.

ARTICLE III.

Sec. I.—The admission fee of this organization shall be \$1.00 for boys and 75 cents for girls for one year, and must accompany an application card.

Sec. II.—Every member is then entitled to a copy of Constitution.

Sec. III.— All application cards shall be signed by the applicant in his own hand writing. If applicant is rejected the dues will be returned.

Sec. IV.—Any member who is expelled from this Club will be allowed 30 days to become reinstated; failure to subject himself for reinstatement within the said 30 days shall be expelled indefinitely.
