## Long-time Thurlow councillor dies at home

The funeral for Fletcher Reid, long-time councillor in Thurlow Township, was held Wednesday from the Belleville Funeral Home and Chapel to Emmanuel United Church, Foxboro.

Mr. Reid served on township council for "about 12 years" recalls Reeve Gerald Masterson, during the 1960s and 1970s. "He was very popular and it was hard to get elected to council with him there," he added.

Reid was a farmer and abattoir operator for many years before retiring due to ill health.

He died Sunday, Nov. 5 at his residence at 2 Yorke Dr., Foxboro.

Besides his wife, the former Laura (Marjorie) Reid, he is survived by three sisters and several nieces and nephews.
