

Gerald Boyce). He married Jane McLaren
 of Melrose. In 1854. Forin moved to
 Belleville and later constructed
 Belleville City Hall (about 1872)

Further information on the purchase
 of land indicated that the council of
 1859 paid 20 pounds for the land and
 awarded the contract for its construction
 for the sum of \$850.00. The stone was hauled
 from Loxdale by teams of horses.

A kitchen and stage renovation was
 added probably in the forties.

The addition of a municipal office was
 first built in 1955 by Clarence Hagerman. In
 1985 this office was enlarged to accomodate
 more staff.

In 1995 an infrastructure grant provided
 money to build a new municipal building
 across the road. Council approved the renovation
 to the old offices to provide space for Tyendinaga
 Public Library. This new facility was
 officially opened February 1996.

With several requests for information on
 the history of Tyendinaga Township Hall, I
 have compiled this article. There was very
 little information to research.
