Jack O'Connor, chief clerk at freight shed, Roy Burnham, express office, Bruce Stoddart, freight. Harry Baldwin, Operator at Deseronto and at Mohawk during World War 1. Charlie Stewart and Charlie Raven were agents at old Deseronto Junction. Frank Allison, Operator at junction, later at Napanee.

As Dad will be 89 in July and is not too well, think he did very well to remember these people and hope the names will be some help to you.
