located on the west half of lot 91 on the second concession, north of the road.

There are still several stones standing in this cemetery. Long ago the Brooks family lived on that farm, and some of the graves are of Brooks family members:

- David Brooks, died January 8 1865 - age 80 years
- Catharine Brooks, wife of David, died Nov. 25 1864 - 70 years
- Charles Burton Brooks, son of C.W. and J., died Dec. 1867 - 6 years

Some of the Delong family are also buried here:

- Phoebe Delong died 1855
- Saphrona Delong died 1855
- Aaron Delong died 1856
- Simon Delong died 1860
- Sarah Delong died 1854

There is also a stone marking the grave of John Vancott who died in 1871.

Another stone records the resting place of Thomas Howard, died 1858, and his wife Charlotte who died in 1848.
