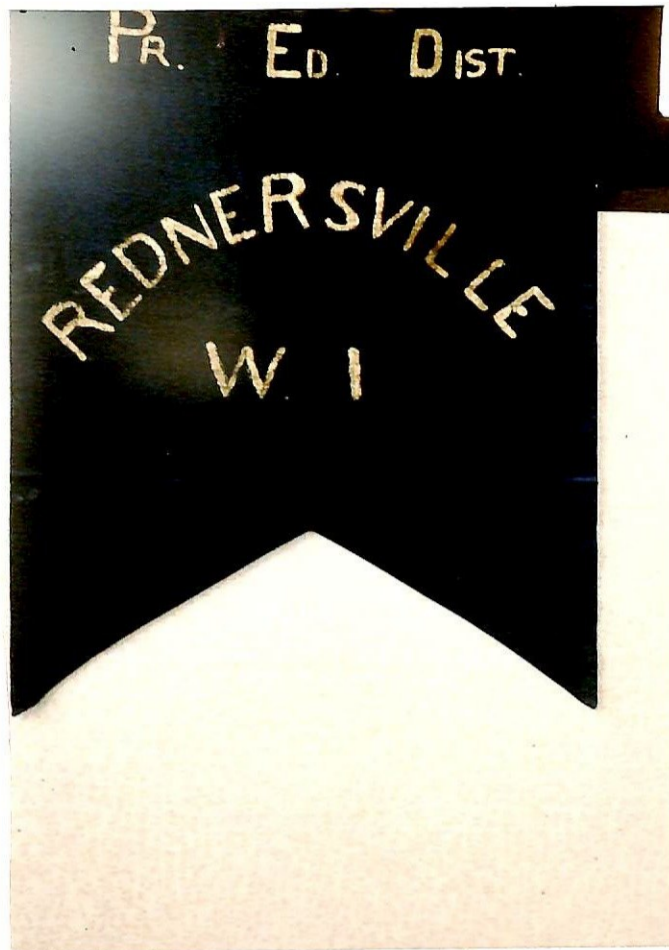
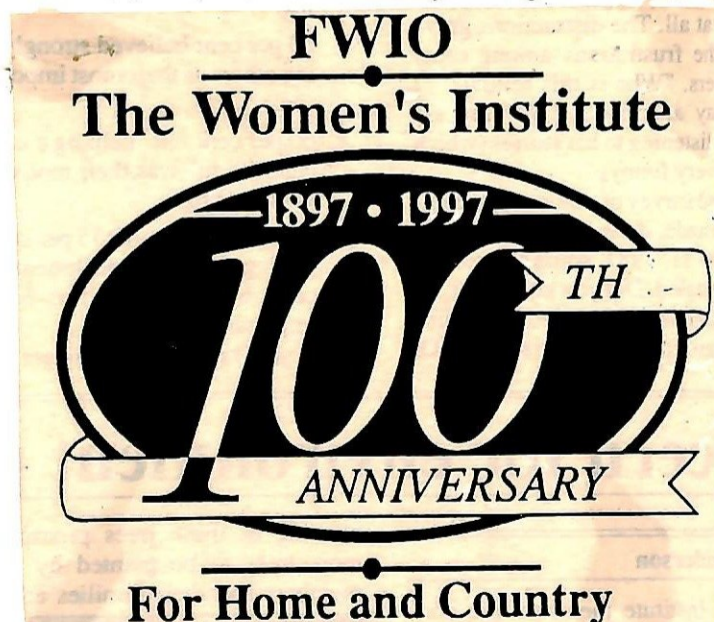


TWEEDSMUIR HISTORYREDNERSVILLE WOMEN'S INSTITUTEBOOK IV
