"LEGEND OF THE SEVEN BUILDINGS"

- An Indian longhouse and teepee overlay.
- The United Empire Loyalist Settlers log house. (depicted on the county's latest book, The Settler's Dream)
- The West Lake Boarding School (Quaker) now a private home near Bloomfield. (for education)
- St. Mary Magdalene Church (now the Prince Edward County Museum.) (for religion)
- A typical county house of clapboard with fretted Baidgeboard trim and Gothic trim. (for family)
- A drive house or carriage house with board and batten over the windows and Gothic tracery forming an ornamental arch. (for transportation)
- To symbolize water and the county, the Salmon Point Lighthouse and quilted sailboats.
