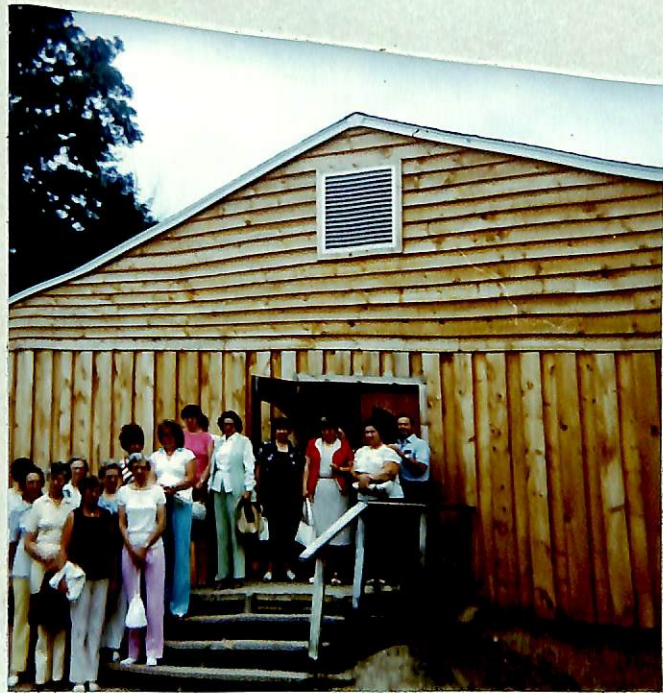
From there they visited a fabric outlet and yarn shop then the heritage silver outlet in downtown Perth.

Leaving Perth they went to Smith Falls and toured the Hershey chocolate plant, including seeing an interesting film.

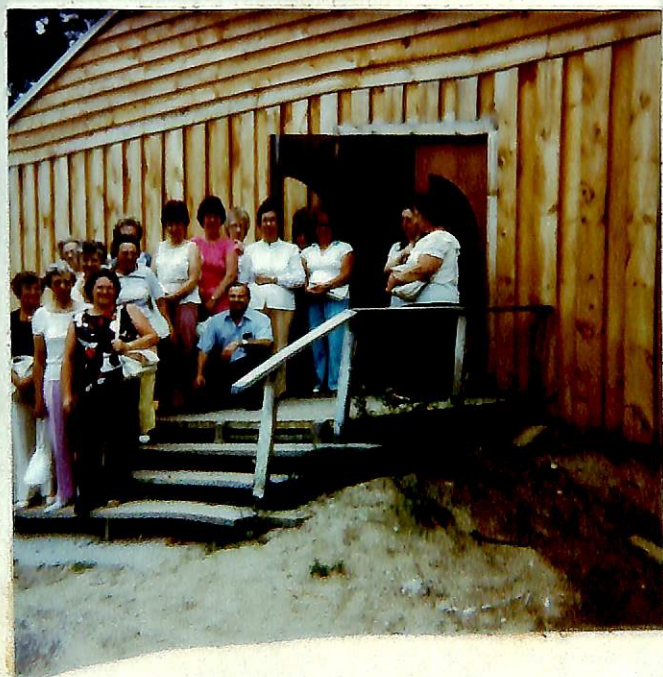
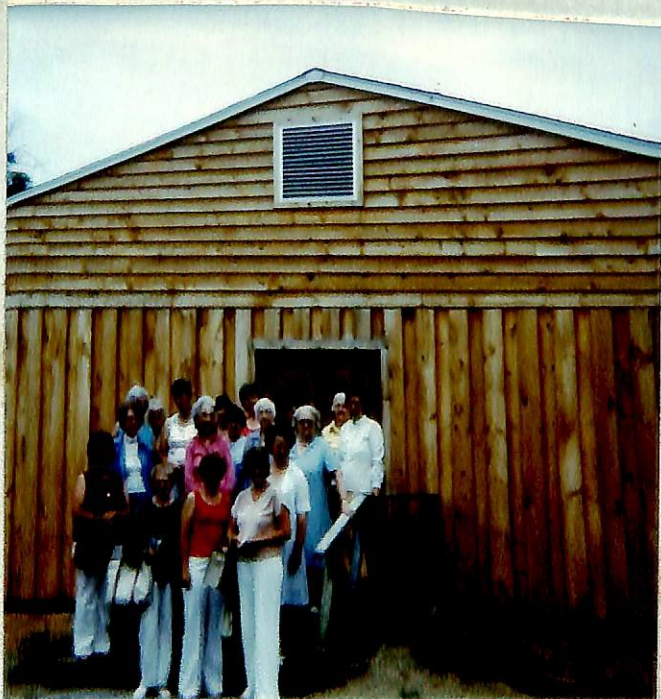
