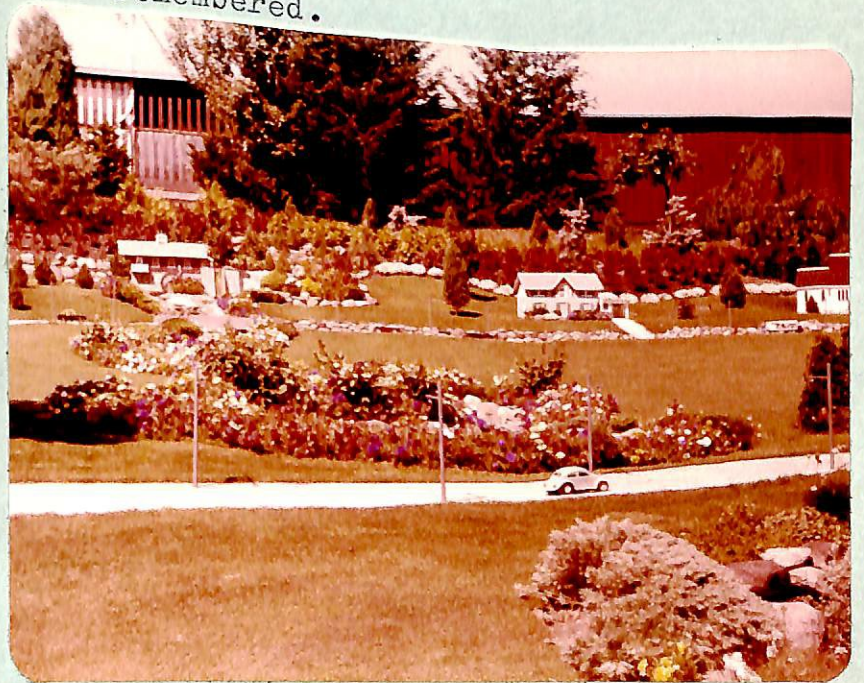


1981 Bus Trip - Mrs. A. Lowe was our driver for our annual summer outing.
