They are interested in acquiring a double bed sized quilt made of many different fabrics, such as velvet, satin, cotton, wool, etc., as many as possible in a quilt of this size, in sections at least 6" x 6". It would be as colourful as possible. It could be either tied or quilted.

This quilt would be used in our Basic Sensory Stimulation Program as an aid in developing profoundly retarded residents' basic senses of touch and movement. This is a brand new program at Prince Edward Heights and staff feel such a quilt would be a valuable asset to the program.

If one of the Women's Institute Branches here in the county would be interested in making this quilt for us, we will, of course, supply all materials and notions required. We would also be very pleased to show the members of the Institute the program area where their quilt would be used.
