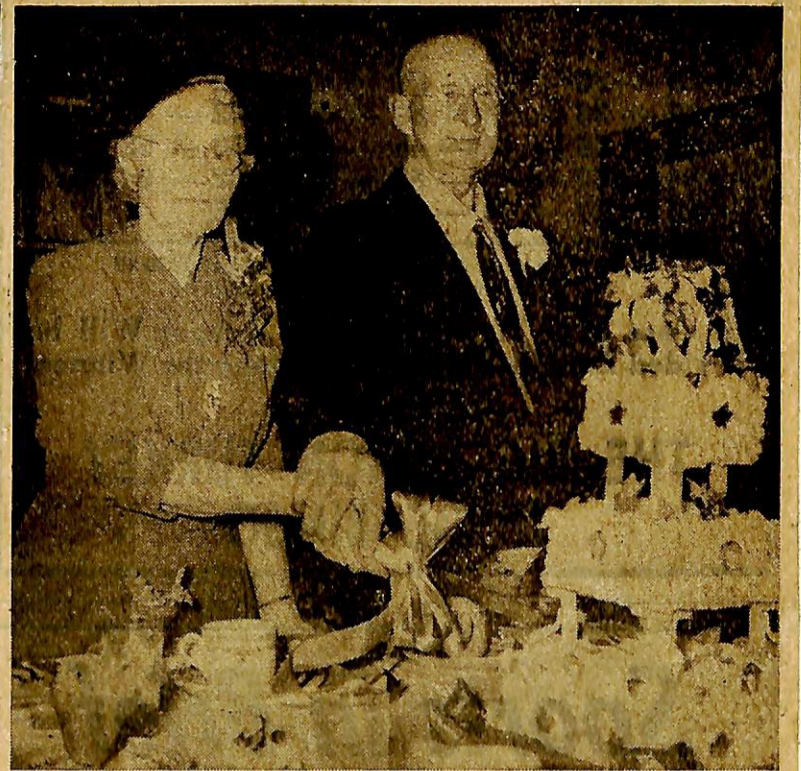


Mark Golden Wedding
