

# DECENDANTS OF DANIEL WAY

(Continued)

Daniel Way, son of Francis Way of Fishkill, Dutchess County, New York, was born April 3, 1743. He married Jemima Kilburn on May 13, 1764 and removed to Northport, Ontario in 1785. He had at least three sons, possibly more, who also came to Canada. James and Samuel are said to have been Quakers. Benjamin apparently was not as he was commissioned a Lieutenant in the Canadian Militia on Dec. 24, 1813. Most of the descendants of James Way are mentioned in "Pioneer Life on the Bay of Quinte" but the descendants of Samuel and Benjamin are not mentioned. They are being traced with much difficulty.

James Way was born April 5, 1765 in New York State and was probably married before he migrated to Canada as the record of his marriage to Sarah Cronk on Sept. 30, 1792 shows that he was then a widower. It is not improbable that Daniel Way who married Catherine Fox may have been his son by his first marriage. James Way's second wife, Sarah Cronk, had seven sons and six daughters, namely, Abraham 1793 died young, Daniel 1794 married Walempy Peck, Lavina 1796 married Abram Lazier, Reuben 1798 married Sarah DeMille, Rachel 1800 married Edward Hoag, Jemima 1802 married Jonathan Noxon, Jacob 1804 married first Alzina Moran and second Delila Harness, Elizabeth 1806 married first James Peck and second William Rippon, James 1808 married first Rebecca Moran and second Almira Bettes, Nancy 1810 married Peter DeMille, Sarah 1812 married Horace Foster, Philip 1814 married Mary Drewry and Margaret Lambert.

Samuel Way (1766-1817) married Catherine Pine and had four sons and two daughters. The oldest, Daniel Samuel (1796-1876) married Susanna Bristol Oct. 3, 1819, Amos married and lived at Uxbridge, Samuel who was twice married and lived at Washington, Lewis who went to one of the Western States, Phoebe who married James MacTaggart in 1816, and Catherine Eliza born Dec. 2, 1806 who married Coleman Bristol on Oct. 27, 1822.

Benjamin Way was born March 5, 1780 and married Catherine Chisholm (1782-1859). He had four sons according to his grandson now living in Toronto, namely, Benjamin who married Charlotte Fairfield, Joseph who lived at Belleville and had three sons and three daughters, Allen (1814-1901) who married Mary Gilbert and John who married and settled in Ohio.

Daniel Way who married Catherine Fox, a sister of Cornelia Fox who became the wife of John B. Way of Ameliasburg, evidently is connected in some manner with this family. His children were Allen, who married first Sarah Prevoux and second Lucinda Prevoux, William who married first Mahala A. Lewis and second Mahala Parry, Eliza A. who married Louis Brown, Alexander married Priscilla Brown, Jane married Edward Thompson, John married Sophronia Cross, Catherine married Colborne Robertson and Rhoda who married B. Salisbury.

John R. Way who lived at Hunniford and died June 23, 1838, aged 44 may have been a brother of Daniel mentioned above. He married Mary Osborne and had three sons and a daughter. The eldest, Jane, married William Trumppour, Edward (1821-1891) married Mary Simpson, Sidney (1823-1918) married Jane Fairman and Thomas who married Hannah Vansicklen.

The writer will be grateful to anyone who can tell him how Daniel Way who married Catherine Fox and John R. Way, whose widow, Mary Osborne, is said to have married second a Mr. Reddick, are connected with the other Way families.

Proceeding to the next generation, first to the children of James Way and Sarah Cronk, Daniel Way and Walempy Peck had James who married Sarah Simpson, Abbott married Harriet Fulford, Matilda married Luke Carscallen, Sarah married John Goldsmith and Content married Anthony Brooks.

Lavina Way and Abram Lazier had Nicholas of Sophiasburg, James married Mary Dossie, John married Sarah Dossie and lived at Churchville, N.Y., Hiram of Syracuse, N.Y., and Sarah who married John Morgan of Sterling.

Reuben Way and Sarah DeMille had Isaac who married Naomi Redner, James W. married Catherine Weese, Sarah A. married Robert Coleman, Mary J. married Thomas McMurter and Laura E. who married John Adams, all of Ameliasburg.

Rachel Way and Edward Hoag had two sons, Charles of Bloomfield and James who went to Chicago.

Jemima Way and Jonathan Noxon had Elizabeth who married Cornelius White, Sarah married Elisha Talcott, Maria unmarried, James married first Carrie White and second Susanna Hendrie, Reuben married first Mary Thomas and second Abbie French, Lydia married Stewart Brown, Jonathan D. married Phoebe Weeks, Philip married Catherine Armitage and went to North Dakota, Caleb married Alzina Tripp.

Jacob Way had by his first marriage, Edward who married Henrietta Stamus and by his second, Gideon S. who married Nellie Lake and lives near Trenton.

Elizabeth Way and James Peck had one daughter Melissa who married Martin Denyes of Thurlow.

James Way had a daughter, Emma, by his first marriage who became the wife of Marshall Johnson of Winnipeg, and by his second, a son, Roland, who married Sarah G. Redner and a daughter, Alzina who married James Johnson and went to California.

Nancy Way and Peter DeMille had Adelaide who married Andrew Price, Irvine unmarried, Norman married Minerva Lazier, Minerva who married a Lazier, Helen married a Davenport and James. The four last named went to California.

Sarah Way and Horace Foster of Newcastle had Wellington unmarried, James who lived in Buffalo, Allen M. married Mary Lazier and lived in Cleveland, Irvine unmarried, George who went to Seattle, Sarah married William McIntosh, Phlona married Dr. Vars of Boymanville, Julia unmarried and Nellie who married Dr. McIntosh of Newcastle.

Philip Way and Mary Drewry of Sophiasburg had Charles E. who married Mary Dempsey, Marcus R. married Mary Lynn and lives in Chicago, Kaziah, Phlona and Annie all unmarried.

Abbott Way and Margaret Lambert of Sophiasburg had Ivan who died young, Manley E. married Nellie Loughheed and Celestia unmarried.

Daniel S. Way and Susanna Bristol had twelve children, six of whom died young. The other six were Louisa who married James M. French of East Tawas, Michigan, John Bristol married Lucinda Jacobs and lived at Queen City, Mo., Anabel Catherine married Albert G. Alexander, San Francisco, Cal., Berthana C. married Cyrus H. Mead, Canton, N. Y., Coleman F. married Eliza Tucker, East Tawas, Mich., and Bidwell (1844-1929) who married Malvina MacLaurin and was Bursar of the Hamilton Sanitorium for more than forty years.

The descendants of Amos, Samuel, Lewis, and Phoebe Way are unknown to the writer. Catherine Eliza Way and Coleman Bristol had ten children, Caroline married Hazzard Purdy, Sarah R. married Sylvanus Outwater, Catherine Jane married Rev. James Lattimer, Phebe Alma married Dr. Harry Verco. The others were Amos S., Mary Ann, Coleman, Benjamin, Lewis W. and Alice L. of whom the writer has no other records.

The children of Benjamin Way and Charlotte Fairfield of Murray are unknown as are those of his brothers, John who went to Ohio and Joseph of Belleville.

Allen Way (1814-1898) and Mary Gilbert had four sons and four daughters, Irving married Carrie Perry and lived in Kansas and later in California, James Leslie married Elizabeth Bingley and lives in Toronto, Caleb married Minnie Duhan and lives in Detroit, John, Ida, Carrie, Catherine all of Trenton, and Minnie deceased.

The grandchildren of Daniel Way and Catherine Fox are mostly unknown. Their daughter, Eliza A. married Louis Brown and had Alfred, John and Albert.

Jane Way and Edward Thompson of Sophiasburg had Nelson, Hannah, George, Mary, Matilda, Letitia and Blake.

John Way and Sophronia Cross had John, Jane, Clarence, Sarah and Walter, Rhoda Way and B. Salisbury of Sophiasburg had Alexander, Peter, Wilhelmina, Zenna, Eldon, Harvey, Daniel, Jesse, Edith and Pearl.

Catherine Way and Colborne Robertson had Henry, William, Catherine and Chrissie.

Jane Way and William Trumppour had Arch who married Phyla Hubbs, Mary married Alexander Chapman, William married Ann Badgley, Miles married Mary Ann Grills, Jane married Sam Grills, Paul married Ella Mains, Belle married Sheldon Smith, Ruth married James Carson and Thomas who married Celia Gullett.

Edward Way and Mary Simpson of Tweed had Mary E. and Elmira S. both unmarried living in Vancouver, Lydia married Albert Lazenby, Ann married James Davenport, Charles married Jane Roth, and George S. married Mary Beckwith.

Sidney Way and Jane Fairman had Melissa who married Stephen Conger Emerson, John (1846-1911) unmarried, George married Ellen Badgley, Thomas of London, Ontario, Billa married Sadie Morrison and lived in Chicago, and Sidney who married Agnes MacAfee and lived in Jamesville, N. Y.

Thomas Way and Hannah Vansicklen had Cora who married William Elliott, Pontiac, Michigan, Alfred married Margaret Foxton, Edward married Minnie Robinson and James married Ella Robinson of Thomasburg, Ontario.
