



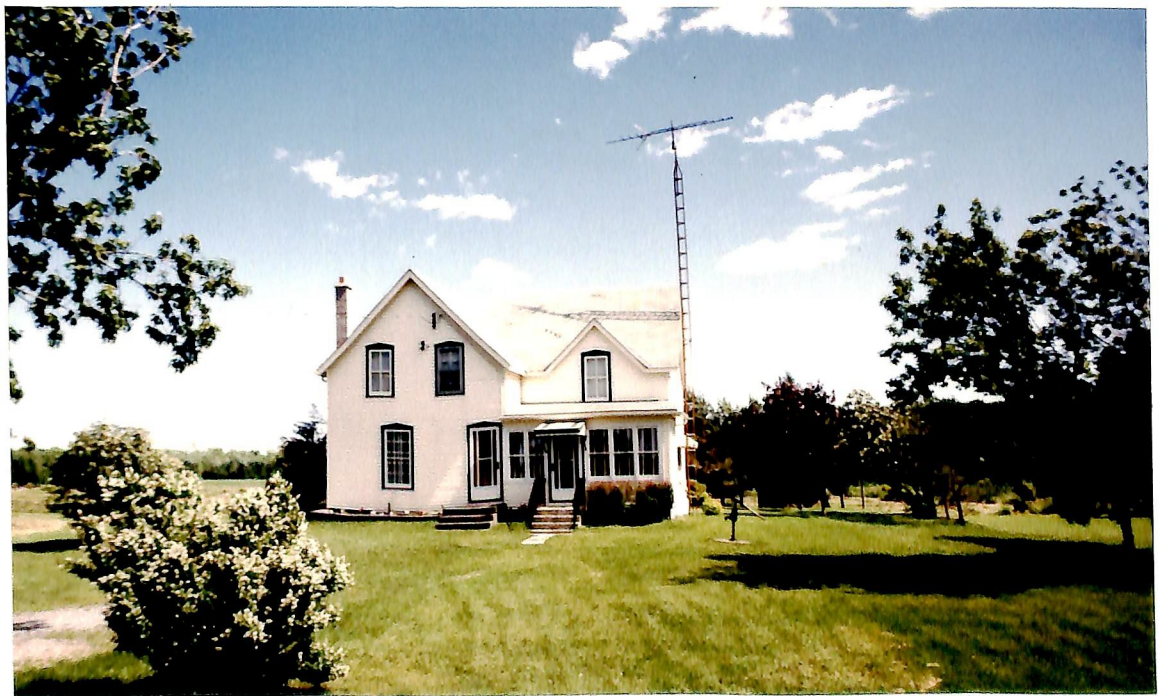
"HOME OF ARTHUR & PHYLLIS LOWE"

As far as we can find out the house was built by "Edward Cronk" on Lot 50 of Sophiasburgh Township in 1910.

We purchased the house and 1.31 acre lot in April of 1965 from "Clarence Calnan", moving in on June 22nd.

The house at that time had a two-storey open verandah at the front, this was removed in 1967 and an addition added in its place, making another bedroom upstairs and extending the length of the kitchen.

Insulation and vinyl siding with black trim was installed in 1978. The front door awning and black iron railing down the steps adds a finishing touch to the house.



CLAYTON AND EDITH CARTER

The Carter home is situated on the south side of County Road 4, west side of lot 55, second concession west of Green Point in the township of Sophiasburgh. This house was built around the turn of the century, -1890-1910, for Mr. and Mrs. Jack Pearsall; it was later sold to Mr. Ernest Norton in 1915.

In 1929, Mr. Norton sold the home to Mr. Charles Carter.

After renovation and installation of hydro, Edith and Clayton Carter, son and daughter-in-law of Charles, moved into this home.

Since that time, a sunporch has been added and central heating installed. Further improvements included plumbing and bathroom.

In 1963, extensive renovations included a new kitchen and dining room.
