

About that snow

It has been snow all the way this year with a total of 111 cm (43 inches) recorded at the Water Purification Plant in Picton, as of Jan. 17.

In the months preceeding Jan. 1 just 46 cm. (18 inches) accumulated. This is less than what fell in one day this January when on the 4th, 49 cm was measured.

But while we may feel we are being buried by snow, figures lag far behind that of last winter.

From the first day of snow until Jan. 17, 1978, the County had to suffer 227 cm (89 inches).
