for the 155 Bat. C.E.F. Cash to the British red Cross 75.00
Cash to the Canadian red Cross 75.00
Cash to the Canadian red Cross 25.00

Boxes packed & sent to the boys overseas. many of
them, while the war was on, approximately \$400.00
adopted a child from Holland \$25.00 & sent 25.00
monthly while the war was on. also adopted
a french boy for \$25.00 & sent 25.00 monthly while
the war was on treats for soldiers \$102.40

Hospital

In 1919 the County Hospital was opened.
donated \$1000.00 to furnish the operating room as
a memorial to our soldier boys.
then \$749.19 sent to Hospital & \$80.00 in bedding.
also \$70.00 for whatever they needed it for.
then \$50.00 a month was sent for approximately 5 years
to help pay for hospital. Then the W.I. furnished
a rest room for \$600.00 flannellette bought to
make nighties & diapers for the hospital at \$4.50 a bolt.
\$500.00 sent to the hospital & \$20.00 to the Hospital
Auxiliary. \$900.00 sent to the hospital for furnishing
of a semi private room #208. From our birthday box
\$14.75 was also donated to the Hospital. a new mattress
for the hospital \$37.00 Donation \$200.00 Hospital

Library

Rented a shop to start a library at \$60.00 a year.

owned the Fitzgerald Block in Wellington to
help them money wise. so in 1928 the new.
