meetings in. They paid Mr. Harris 25.00 month toward  
what they owed him. until they got the new library  
they were paying \$60.00 a year for a small part of  
a building. also they furnished 2 doz chairs. dishes &  
tables. at the cost of 25.20 also a shelf of books.  
for the library for the sum of 50.00. The W. I. put  
on a banquet for the library cost of the banquet 70.00  
paid the librarian 25.00 bought towels price 14.50  
Donation to the library 48.60

The Wellington W. I. paid for the Cemetery gates & had  
them put on. they paid \$3.50 until the gates was paid  
for

## School.

1922 the new consolidated school was opened  
the W. I. Sponsored the first & last school fair  
donated the lunches at noon. purchased hot plates  
utensils & dishes & cutlery for serving hot meals to  
the children. also for the sewing room, scissors  
ironing boards & sewing supplies. The W. I. bought  
a piano for the domestic science room for the school.  
price 64.00. also put on a banquet for the school  
board cost 50.00 donated 5.00 each to the two top  
students at graduation. also donated tea towels, & 2  
towel holders. now we pay 35.00 each for 2 top student

## Light

The W. I. had the first lights installed in the  
park at Wellington. also donated picnic tables, seats  
benches, restored the bandstand and planted the  
first trees & shrubs. cost of the lumber for repairs  
\$62.000
