

CURRENT EVENTS

1894--December 25, Married, Alfred Henry Tyrer and Mary Adelaide Golden.

1896--Elijah Smith and Amy Brown married August 19.

1896--Married, Joseph Brook and Fanny Armishaw.

1901--Easter Vestry Meeting in St. John's Church, Stanleydale was very encouraging. Returns showed all accounts paid in full and as a token of goodwill, the Vestry presented the Clergyman with \$5.00. Messrs. Armstrong and Turley were re-elected wardens of the church.

1908--December, Stisted Municipal Elections, A.E.Scott 56 and W.H.Demaine, 50 votes.

1911--Some important changes are being made in the Stisted Mail route in April. After the 13th the Stanleydale Post Office is to be closed permanently and the former patrons will therefore get their mail at Ashworth P.O.

1911--September-Fire destroys barn and contents of W.H.Demaine. Small children smoking straws in haymow were cause of fire.

1911--September-Stisted Show was very successful and many friends from Ravenscliffe and Huntsville patronized it.

1906--October 3, married, William Boles and Eliza Smith.

1912--Telephone line extension towards Aspdin. W.H.Demaine had first two telephones in Ashworth about 1908.

The earliest form of telephone system was that of Emperor Shi Huang Ti. It consisted of brass tubing between guard stations along China's 1500 mile Great Wall.

1914--February 19--New phones have recently been installed in homes of Messrs. Wm. Hines and George Crompton of Aspdin. Now 54 phones on Stisted Line, 11 installed this year.

1913--Injured and maimed for life at the Golden Mill at Aspdin, Mr. John Morrison of Utterson and also James Clarke of Aspdin, one of the original owners of what is known as the Golden Mill, was painfully injured when his left hand came in contact with the trimmer saw.

1913--Another report reaches this office of the Huntsville Forester of an extraordinary tree recently scaled. Mr. Wm. Lalor is the authority for the story that he and Walker Hanes scaled a pine tree which measured in the aggregate 4904 feet and was valued at \$75.

1915--Died of wounds, War 1, James Edwin Hall, second son of Mr. and Mrs. W.J.Hall.

1916--May 4, married, Reginald G. Hodge and Sara Alice Armstrong.

1918--Fire destroys home of Hy. Dixon on February 1 in 40 degrees below zero weather. Fire started in kitchen chimney. Loss is \$2,500 and no insurance.

1922--July 4, married, Gordon Langridge and Esther Brook.

1923--February 26, Virgilio Grosso and Florence E. Blundell

1923--July 5, George Bernache and M.Eorline Demaine.

1923--June 16, Golden Wedding Anniversary of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Armstrong.

1924--July 2, married, Gordon Brook and Ellen Matilda Smith.

1924--September 3, Cedric Hodge and Viola Mick were married.

1924--October 25, married, Wilfred Tipper and Lucy Emberson.
