May 11, 1883 - Mr. J. W. Alford's tender of \$2,150.00 for the "Erection and completion of a new Methodist Church on the south east corner of Lot 12, Concession 2, South Monaghan, was accepted".

Nov. 5, 1883 - Committee reported surplus brick not required for building was sold to Alexander Emberson for \$6.50 per 1000 new bricks, and \$5.00 per 1,000 for old ones. Resolved to push ahead with collection of subscriptions for an Organ Fund to range from 50 cents upwards.

Trustees of Bensfort Church elected at Bailieboro were:- Wm. Emberson, Wm. Dawson, Edward Kerr, David Truscott, Joseph Dawson, John Smith and Jeffry Widows.

Ct. 5, 1990 - Bensfort Church Anniversary. Sermons morning and evening by Rev. Bell of Bethany. Good congregation in the morning, crowded house at night. Collection \$8.00. Tea on Monday from 4 P.M. to 7 P.M., attendance poor in consequence of rain. Proceeds of tea \$38.00. Stirring speeches were delivered by Rev. Mr. Greatroc, Cavanville and Rev. Bell. Excellent music rendered by the church added to the interest of the service. A social was given the following Thursday evening to dispose of the surplus eatables. Proceeds of Social \$15.00.
