

... Our New Heating System ...

A Committee was formed in October, 1961, composed of Mrs. K. Dawson, B. Kelly, J. Lewis, J. Plews A. Watt and E. White, to look into the matter of a new heating system for our church.

After receiving plans, estimates, etc. of many different types of heating, the committee decided unanimously to recommend to the congregation to accept the quotation of Mr. Lloyd Atchison, South Monaghan, to install "Pye Thermodare" Infra-Red Radiant Heating.

Although this type of heating is comparatively new, there are at present some 25 churches in Ontario with a similar heating system installed by this company. By adopting this system we avoided the many problems which would have been involved in excavating under the building and particularly the matter of high water in the spring, which was evident.

There are eight 4.0 K.W. units in the main body of the church, along with one 2.0 K.W. unit at the entrance and the same in the ante-room. In the church hall there are seven 3.0 K.W. units and in the kitchen four 2.0 K.W. and one 1.2 units. These units may be adjusted as to direction, and in the church proper each unit has an individual switch.

Special mention should be made of the many hours of free labour donated by several members of our congregation, especially Mr. Eldridge White who stayed on the job full time until it was completed.

Mr. R. Kelly is Chairman of our Building Committee and the footings for the extension of our hall have already been laid. However, until the Heating System is paid for we intend to delay construction.

Donations to the Heating System may be sent to Mr. Alex Watt, Chairman of the Finance Committee, or may be placed on the collection plate in an envelope marked "Heating Fund". The special collection at this service will be applied towards this fund.
