Council Meeting, Town Hall, Blackstock Jan. 13, 1913

Rev. Kidd appeared before the Council stating he had a communication from the Minister of Militia stating that there would be an armoury building built in Blackstock if the Municipality would furnish a site. On motion of Councillor Hyland and Forder that the whole Council be a committee to investigate re a site.

Council Meeting, Town Hall, Blackstock, Feb 3, 1913

*San Hughes*

Rev. Kidd stated that he had a communication from the Minister of Militia re site for armouries & com. from the Agricultural Society wanting them to purchase the fair grounds. Moved by Councillor Van Camp and Forder that this council purchase the fair grounds if satisfactory arrangements could be made. Moved by Counc. Forder and Hyland that the Reeve (James Byers) and clerk (Wm. Beacock) be a com. to purchase of fair grounds.

Council Meeting, Town Hall, Blackstock, Mar. 3, 1913

Moved by Couns. Van Camp & Forder that clerk notify chairman of Agriculture Soc. that this Council are prepared to negotiate with them re fair grounds.

Special Meeting, Town Hall, Blackstock, Ont. Mar. 14th, 1913

Moved by Couns. Hyland & Van Camp that this Council purchase a site from R. McNally for an armouries building if needed. Left to Reeve & Clerk re purchase of same.

Council Meeting, Town Hall, Blackstock, June 2nd, 1913

By-Law No. 561 was duly passed signed and sealed, purchasing the old Fair grounds for a public park for the sum of \$500.00 (other portions to be...)

Council Meeting, Town Hall, Blackstock, July 7, 1913

Moved by Counc. Hyland and Forder that the Reeve and Couns. Van Camp communicate with Agricultural Society re renting of fair grounds for exhibitions.

Council Meeting, Town Hall, Blackstock, Nov. 3, 1913

Moved by Counc. Van Camp and Forder that this Council present Lew. Col. J. Hughes with a letter of address on the occasion of the laying of the corner stone of the Drill Hall, at Blackstock.
