

PURCHASE OF ARMORIES AND LAND:

Blackstock, Mar. 7, 1950

Reeve Measlip reported what he had done re armories as all former arrangements had been cancelled and armories were being turned over to War Assets for sale and reeve had wrote requesting that Township be given 1st opportunity to purchase same.

Moved by Coun Cochrane, sec. by Coun. Sweet that Council approved of action taken by Reeve, carried.

Blackstock, Ont, April 15, 1950

Special meeting called to consider making an offer on armories. Bruce Measlip, Reeve, in chair. Com. from Crown Assets Disposal Corp. re Armories read.

Moved by Councillor Cochrane, sec. by Councillor Black that an offer of \$400.00 be made on armories.

Special Meeting, Blackstock, May 18, 1950

Council met on the above date to consider Com. re Armories from Crown Assets Disposal Corporation.

Com. requested \$3,500. for Building. 20% cash bal. could be arranged on time. After considerable discussion, Moved by Coun. Suggitt, sec. by Coun. Black that Council make an offer of \$2,000. 20% down bal at 3% subject to approval of Municipal Board. Building to be part of Recreational Centre.

Blackstock, Sept. 5, 1950

By-Law 922 A By/Law to rename the Armories as the Cartwright Community Recreational Hall and add same to the already existing Cartwright Community Centre.
