

First School - was erected near Taylor's Corner (where Scugog Road meets # 7 Highway). It was probably built of log.

Second School - Was on Stuart Dorrell's property (1970), south of the Dry Creek, by the culbert on the east side of the road. This school was burned down about 1895. The teacher, Mr. Barclay, got a salary of \$175 a year. SEE THE PICTURE OF THE SCHOOL AND PUPILS ON THE FOLLOWING PAGE.

Third School - was built in north Blackstock in 1895. It is still in use (1970). It had a partition down the middle upstairs and the downstairs was also used for classes.
