POLICEREPORT

Cobourg OPP and the Northumberland Crime Unit are investigating a home invasion that occurred Sunday evening in Hope Township.

At approximately 10:50 p.m., a young make knocked on the door of the residence. He said he was lost and requested the use of the p[hone to call his mother.

Once inside the home, he distracted the female victim allowing two masked persons to enter into the home undetected. One person was armed with a baseball bat and the other a handgun. The

invaders confronted the women, who yelled for her husband while struggling with one of the offenders.

The three offenders fled the residence on foot into a wooded area. The victim was not injured.

The OPP Canine Unit responded. The baseball bat and a black ski mask were located a short distance from the residence. It is suspected the offenders made their getaway in a motor vehicle.

The three offenders are described as:

n young male, approximately 12 years old, five foot five inches tall,, wearing a long black coat, black baggy jeans, white running shoes. He was described as being East Indian.

n a male, approximately six foot two inches, with a dark coloured ski mask, and a dark jacket;

n a male, approximately five foot 10 inches tall wearing a navy-coloured ski mask with red trim around the eyes, a blue sweater and blue jeans.


