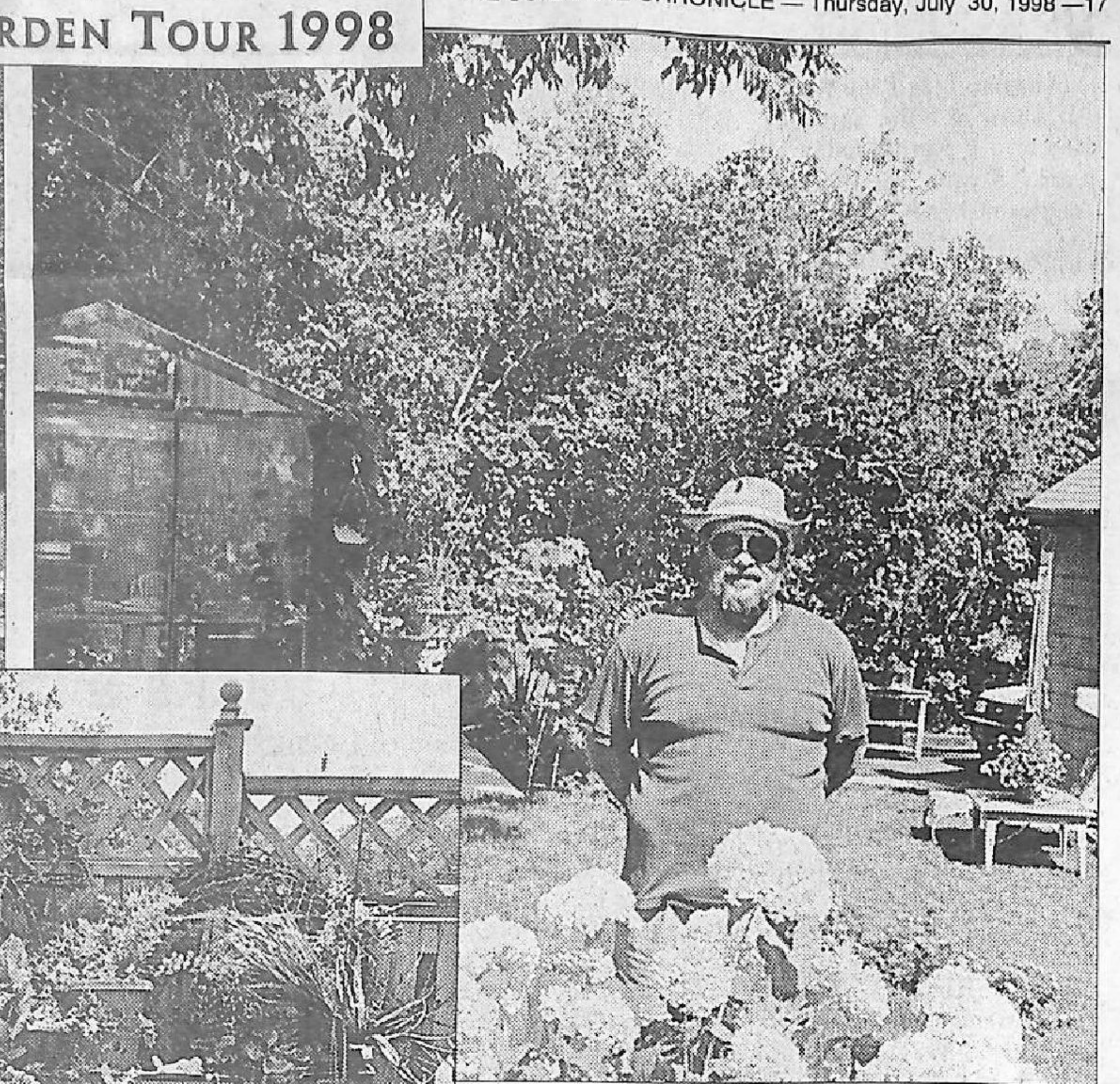
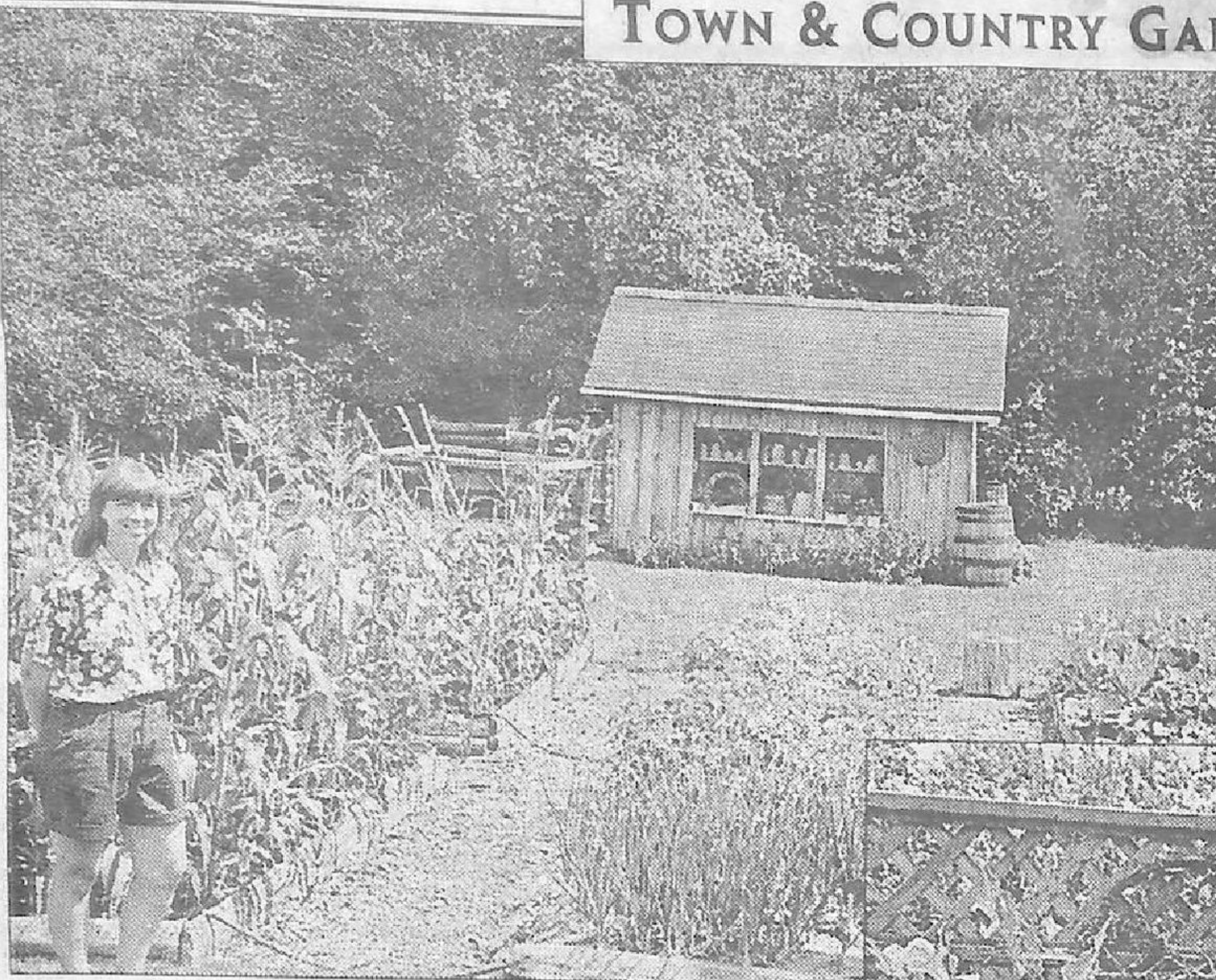


# TOWN & COUNTRY GARDEN TOUR 1998
