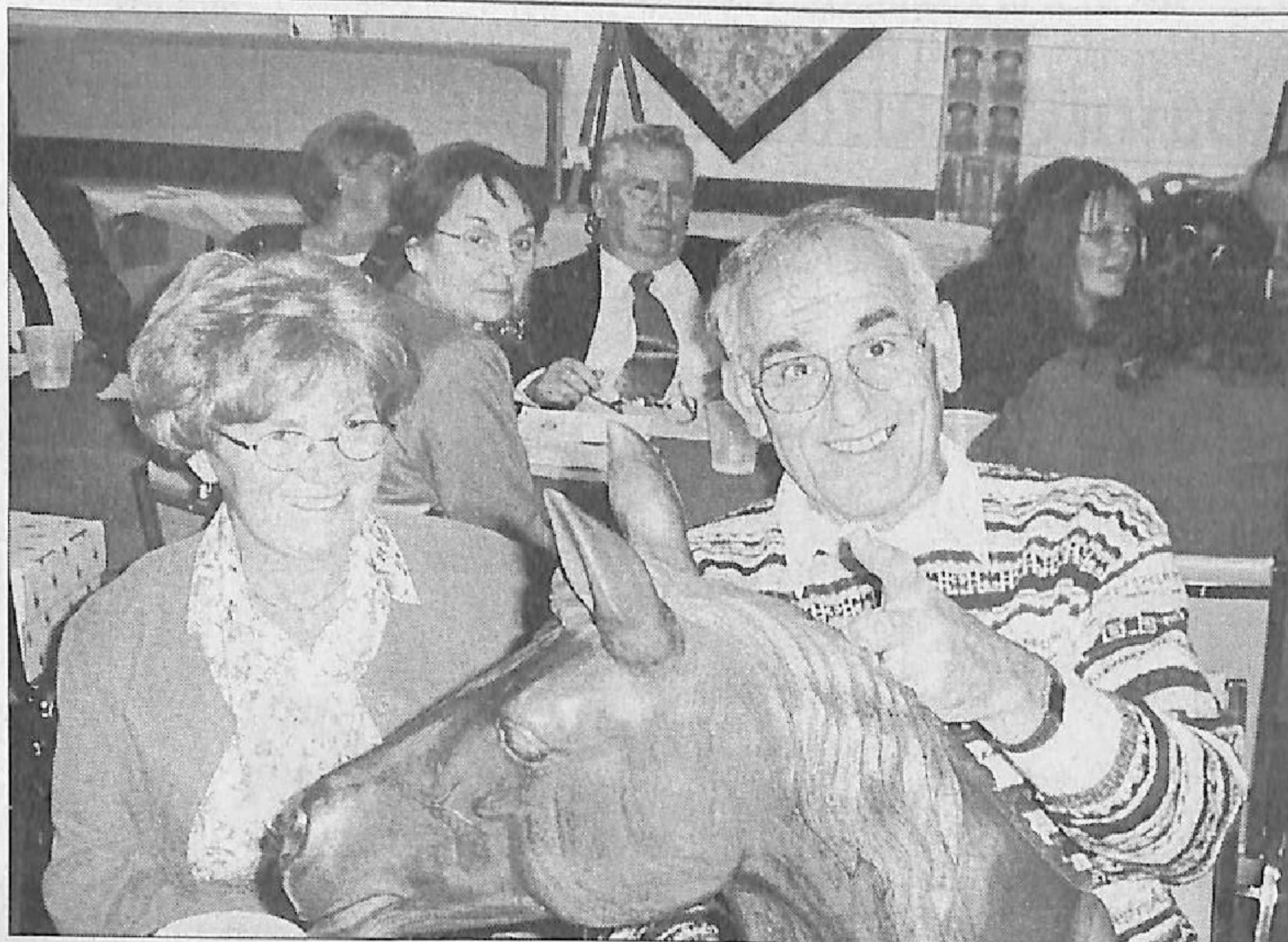


12TH ANNUAL COLBORNE ROTARY HARVEST AUCTION
