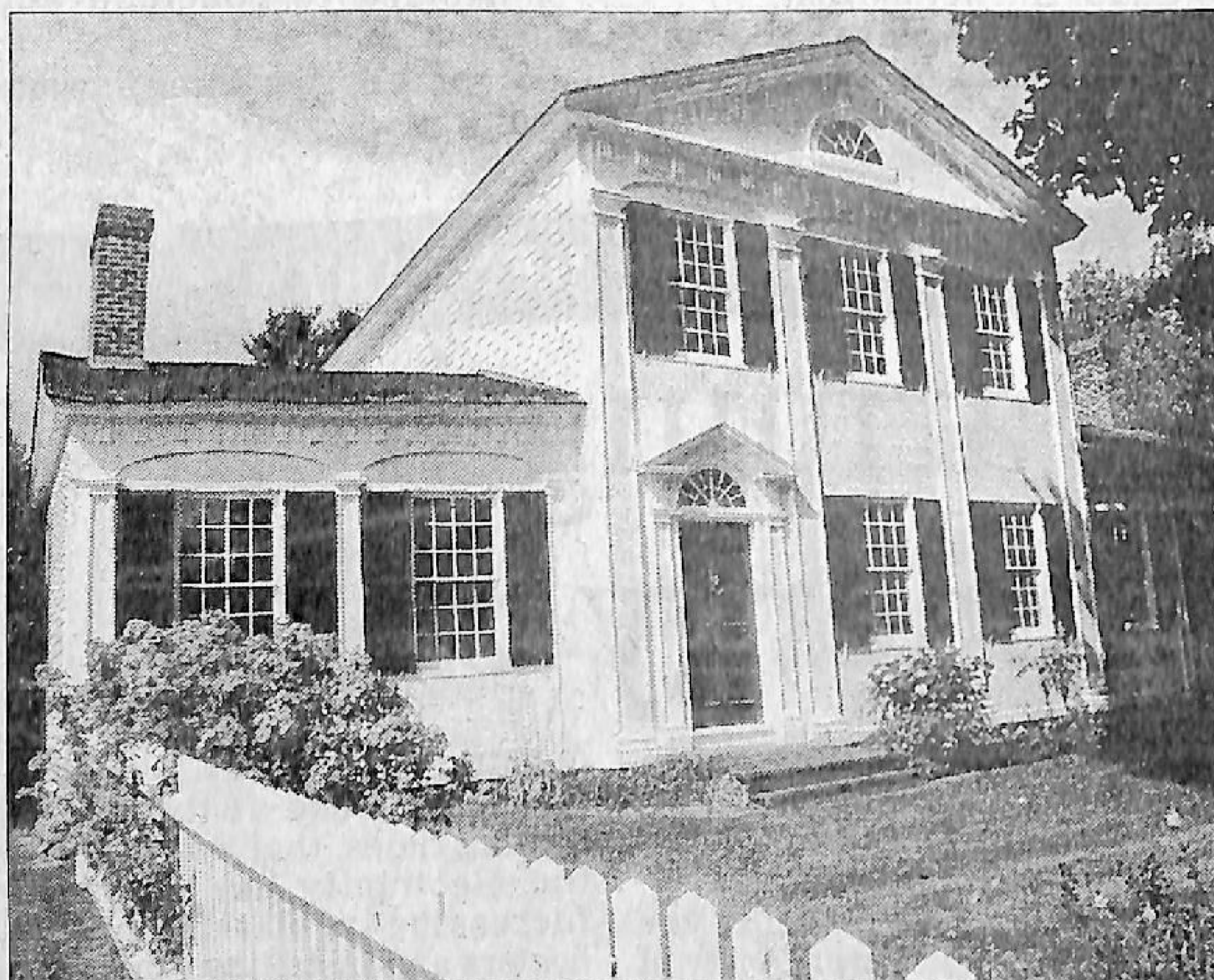


# LOCAL NEWS

This is the last weekend this season to view historic Barnum House, a National Historic Site operated by the Ontario Heritage Foundation at Grafton. Eliakim Barnum immigrated to Haldimand Township from the United States about 1807. The successful entrepreneur built his home in 1819.

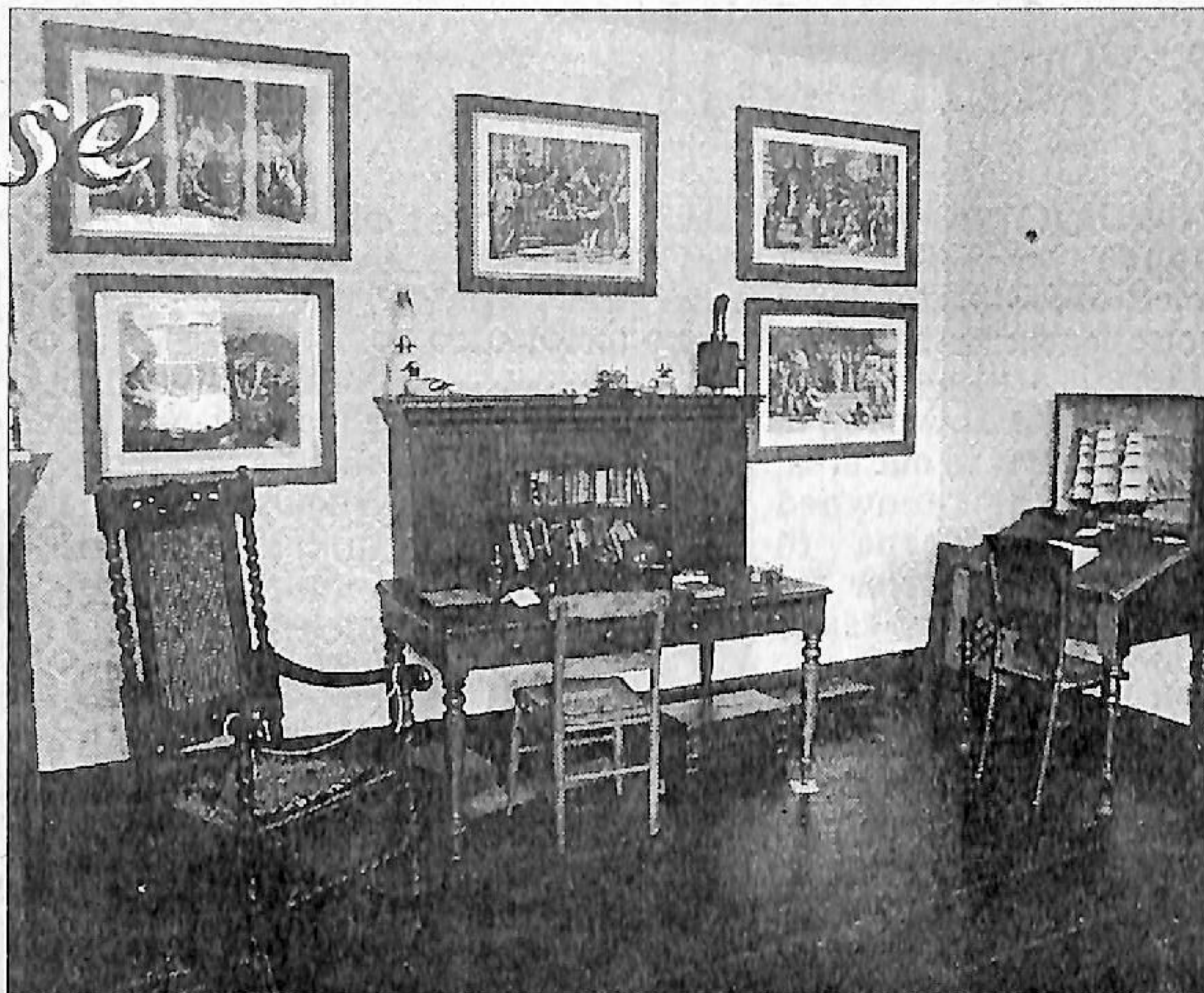

The office, above, was used for business for Mr. Barnum. Different colored ink wells (black and red) indicate ledger work was done here.

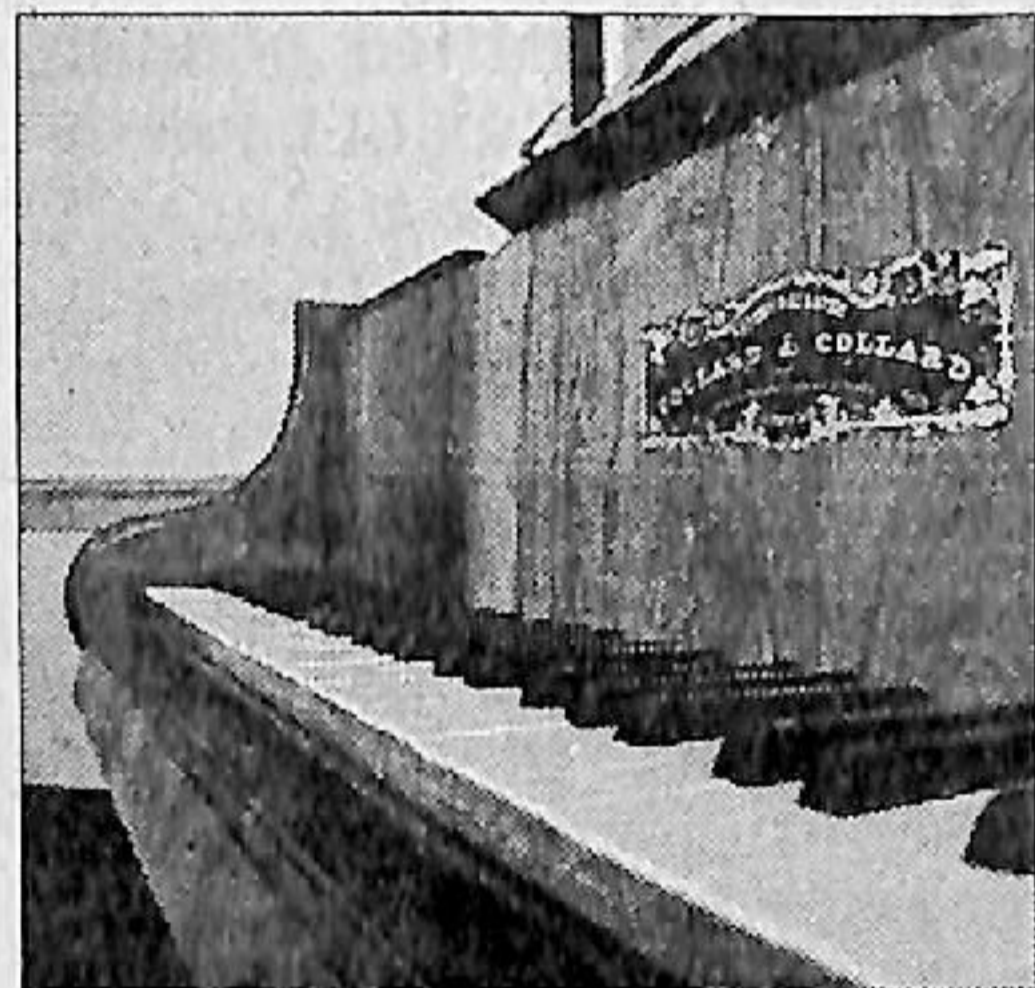

The Collard & Collard Repetition Action Clementi/Harp sits in the parlor room.

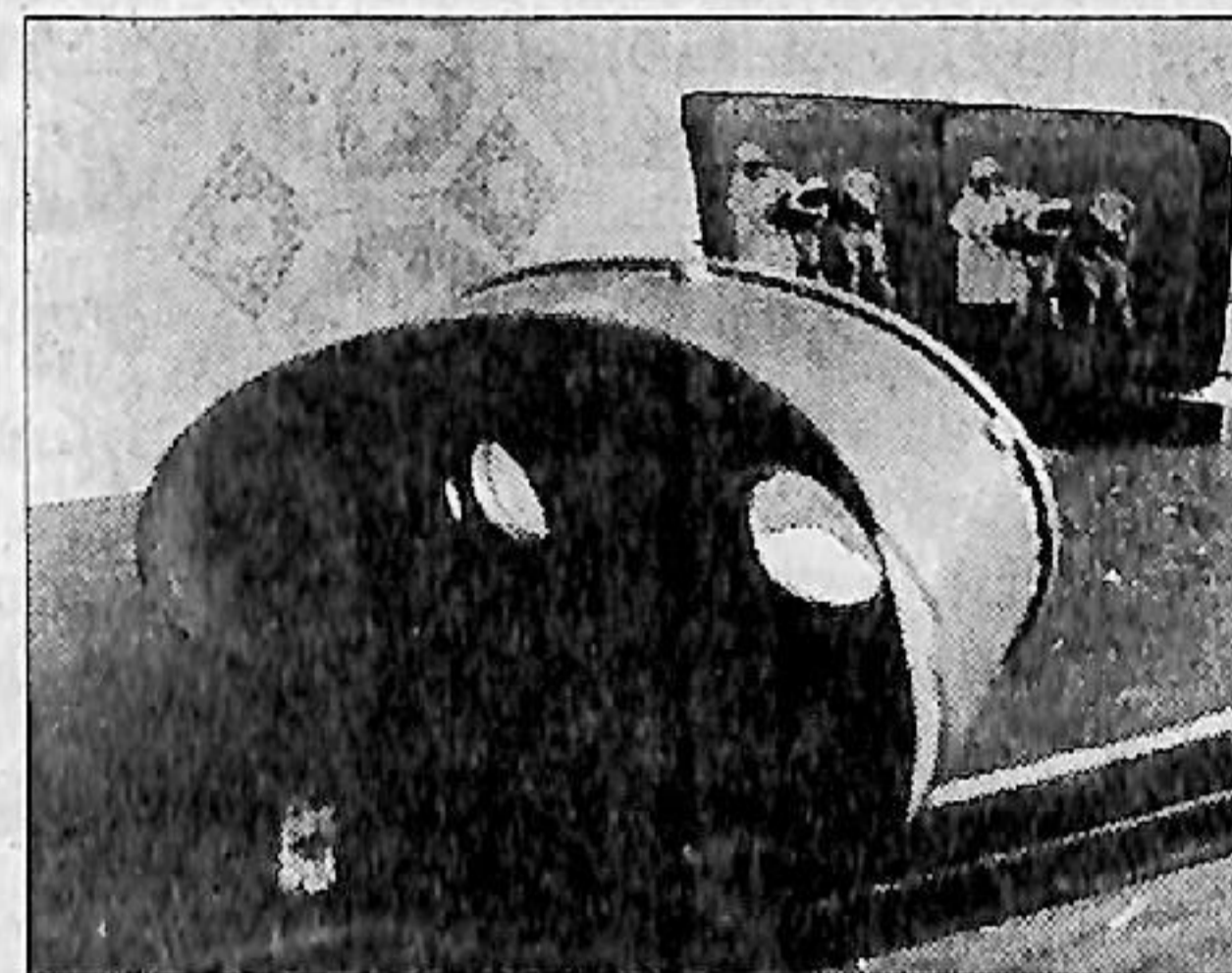
