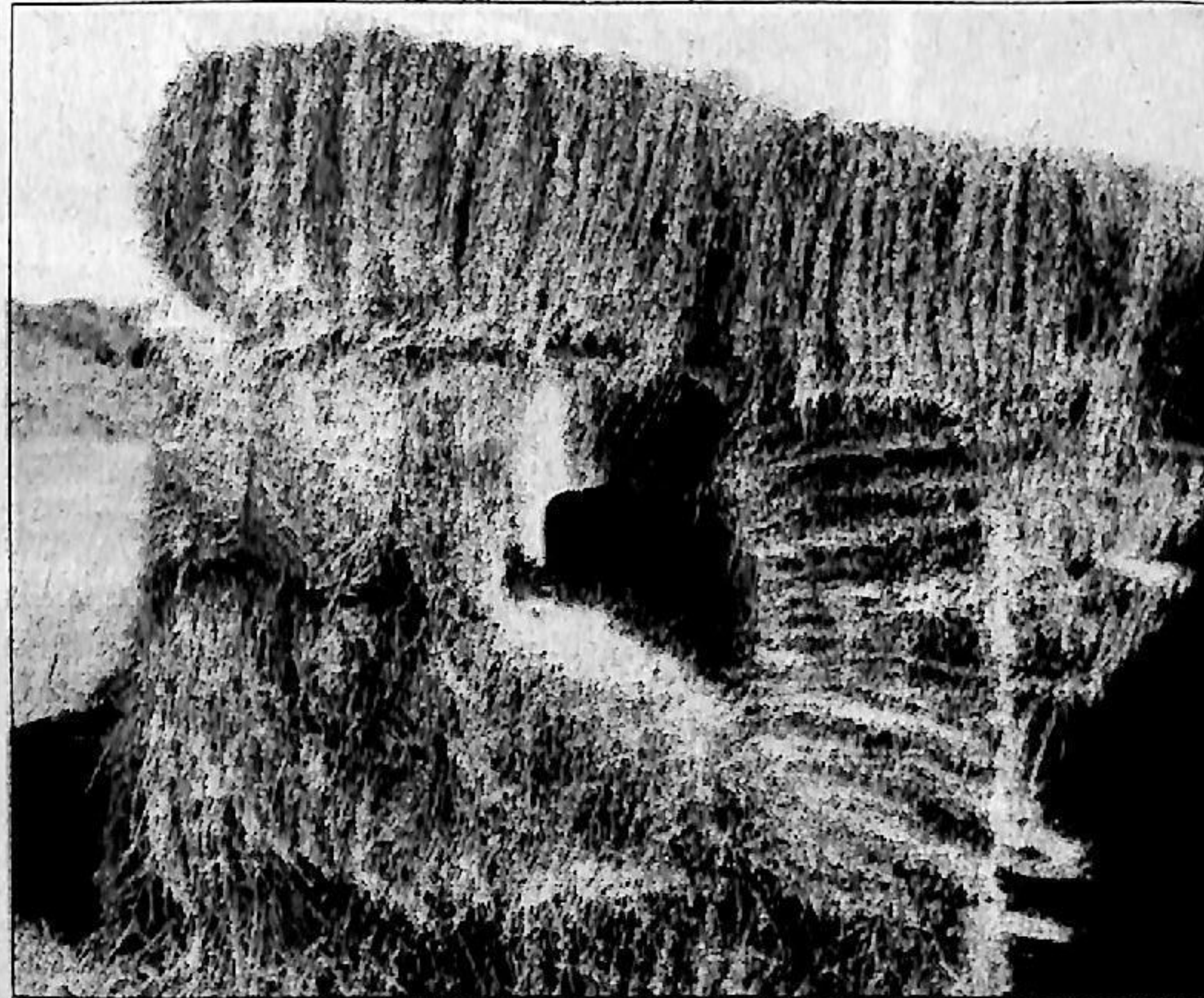

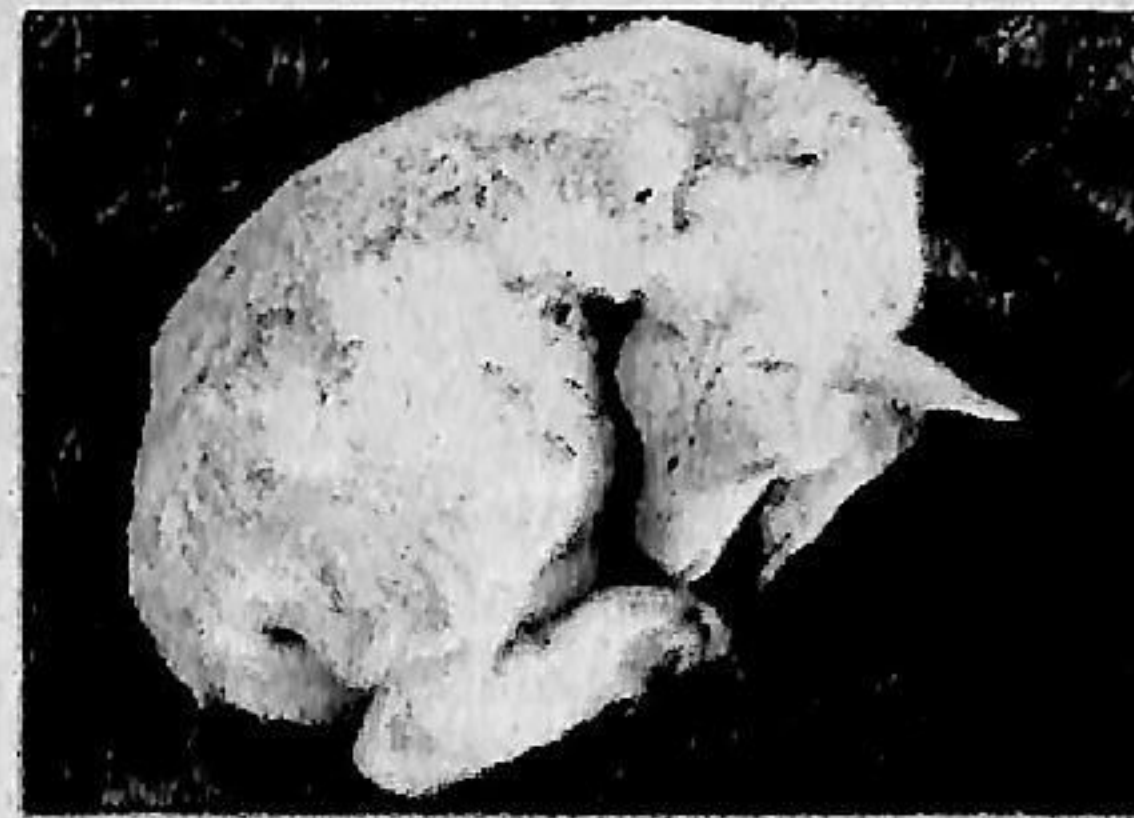

HAY HOME: Robert Boomer of Cambridge peeks out of a straw "house" at Pieter's Appleyard in Colborne.



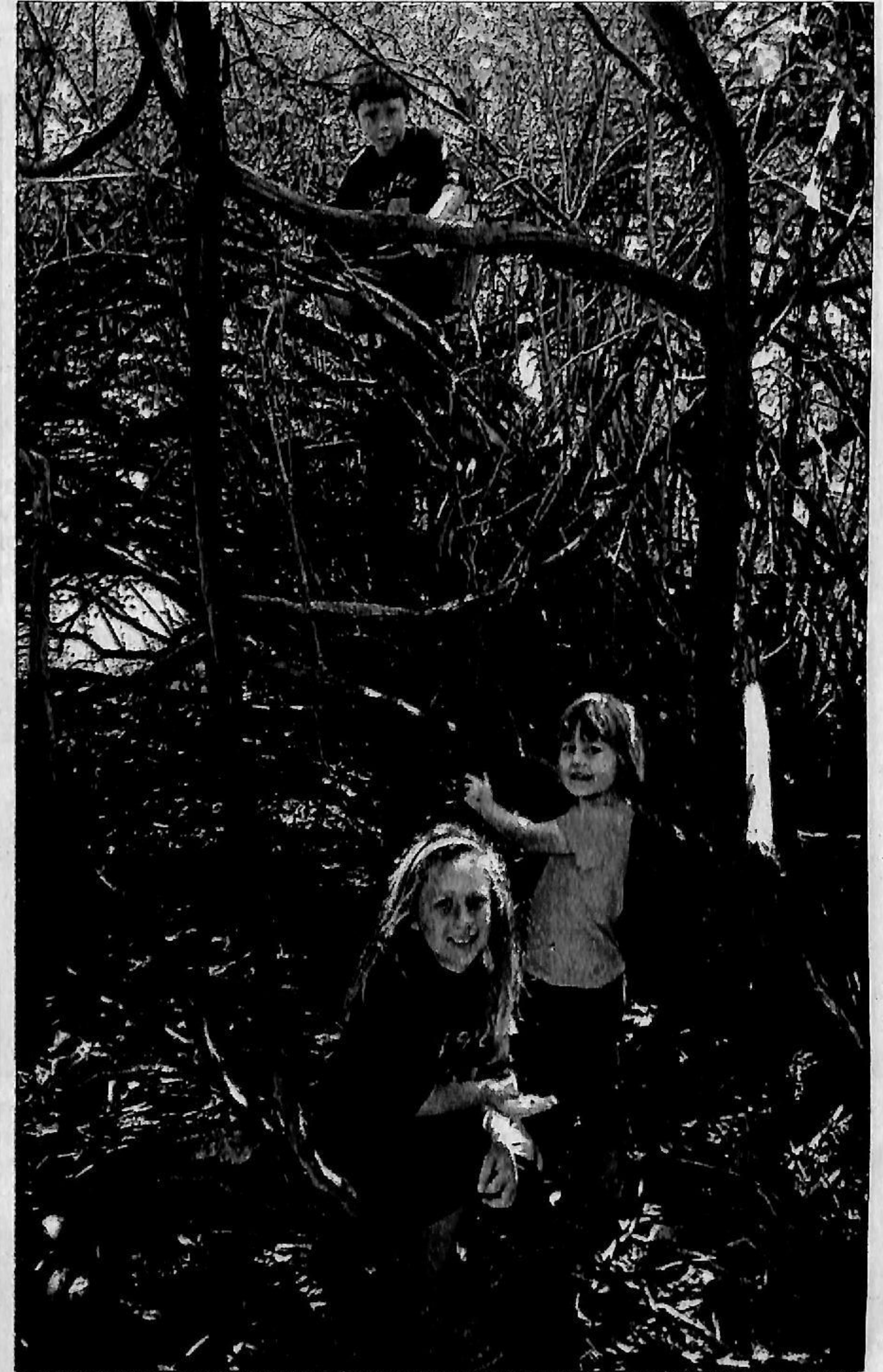
