**Guest Preacher**

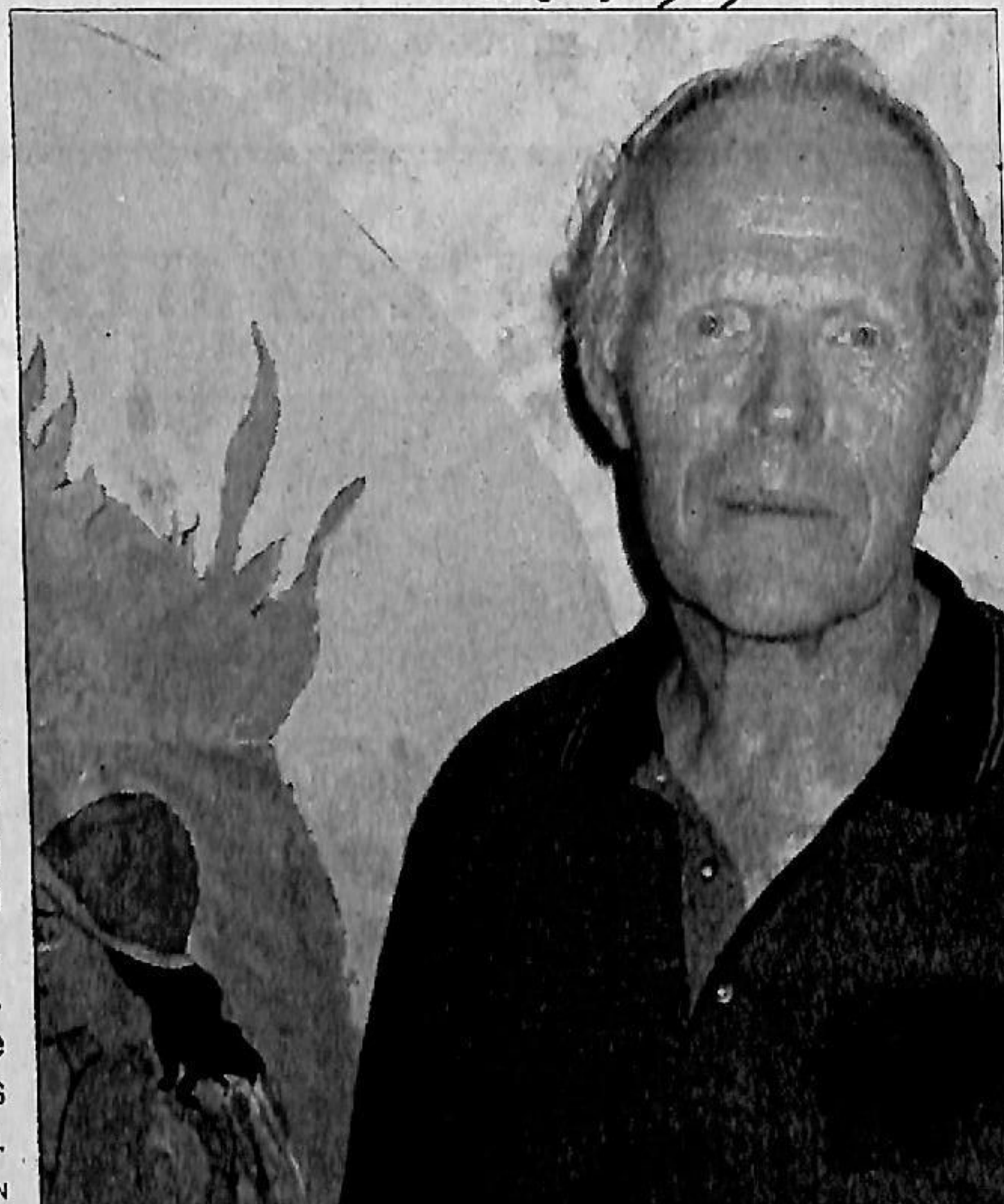
