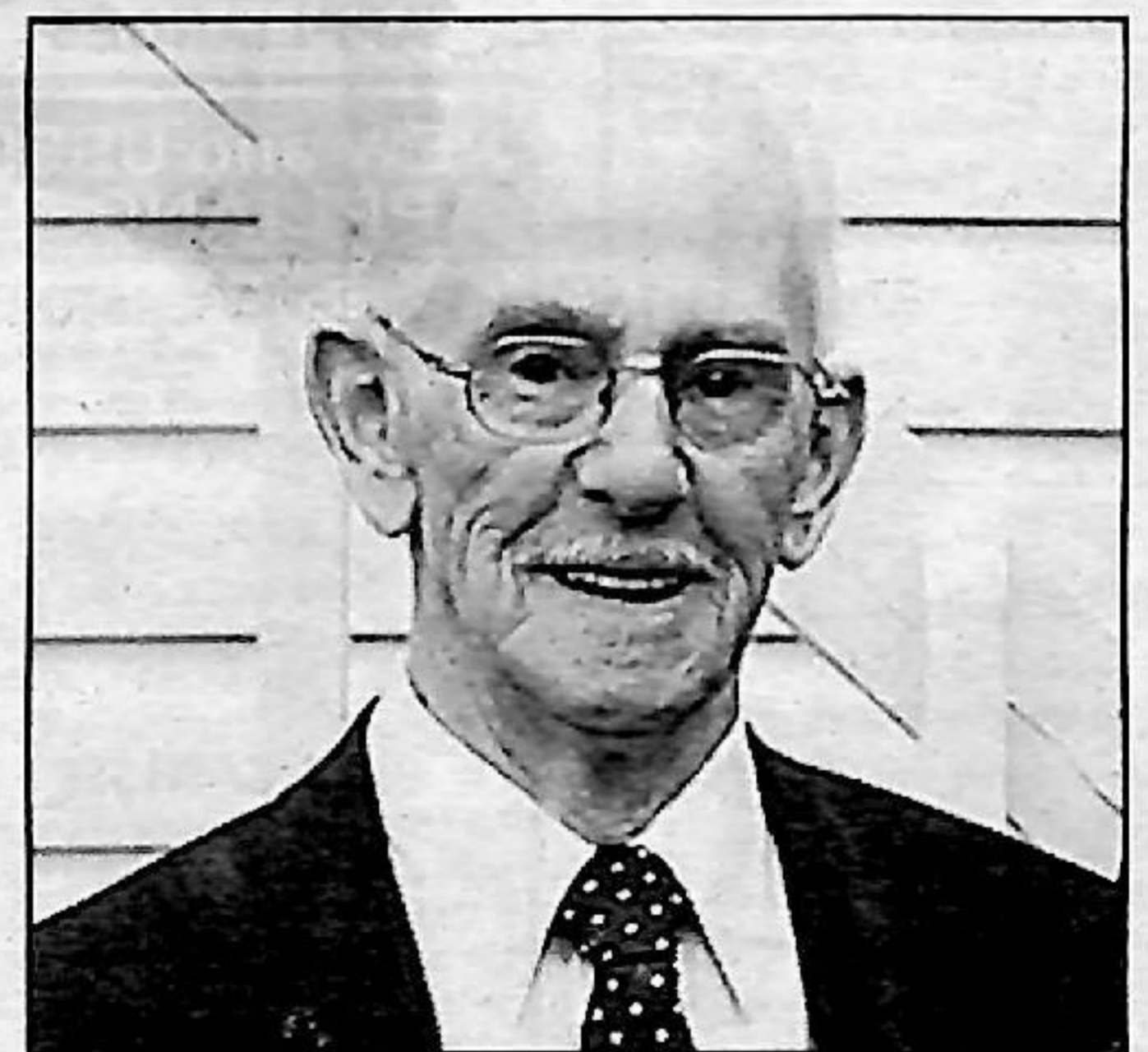
DEATH NOTICES
