Waite Cemetery By-Laws - April 2008

Sale and Transfer of Lots

Definition:

A For the purpose of these By-Laws a lot is a single grave space. B For the purpose of these By-Laws a plot is multiple lots.

Price of Lots:

Interment rights to lots shall be sold at prices set by the Board Members and filed with the Ministry of Government Services, Cemeteries Regulation Unit.

Contract:

All purchasers of Interment Rights must sign a contract with the Cemetery as adopted by the Board Members and filed with the Ministry detailing obligations of both parties and acceptance of the By-Laws.

No Resale

No interments rights may be resold.

Form of Certificate:

Interment Rights shall be conveyed by such form of Interment Rights Certificates as adopted by the Board Members and filed with the Ministry.

INTERMENTS

Permits:

A burial permit issued by the Division Registrar showing that the death has been registered or in the case of cremation a Certificate of cremation must be deposited with a Board Member before an interment may take place.

Cremation Interments

Cremations may be interred in lots other than cremation lots including family plots.

Disinterments

All disinterments will be done in accordance with the Cemeteries Act.

MONUMENTS AND MARKERS

Definition

A For the purpose of these by-laws a marker shall be understood to be any permanent memorial structure.

B For the purpose of these by-laws a monument shall be any marker that is not flush with the ground.

Only one Monument to a Plot

No more than one monument may be erected or placed on a plot regardless of the number of graves in that plot.

Foundations

All monuments taller than one (1) foot shall have a four (4) foot deep foundation at the owner's expense.

Installments

All markers are to be installed with the Board Member's approval.

Care and Maintenance Fund

All markers installed in the Cemetery shall have the proper amount of money deposited in the Care and Maintenance Fund as regulated in the Cemteries Act.

Flat monuments must be at least 4 inches thick and have concrete apron around the marker to depth of four inches. This is to prevent the monuments cracking.

All monuments must conform to the following height restrictions: Monuments up to 32" must be at least 6"

Any monument higher than 55" must have plans submitted to the Board Members for approval and may be denied for practical

One footstone with a flat level surface set flush with the ground may be placed at each grave (in addition to the monument). This footstone shall be placed at the end of the grave farthest from the monument. All footstones are to be installed with the Board

All markers or monuments must be

Off The Ground

All flowers must be potted and placed in a stand of which the design has been approved by the Board Members. The stand is to be

Fresh Flowers and Smaller Pots

No chair or bench, wooden or wire trellis, arch or iron rods or similar articles shall be brought to or left upon the lots.

The Board Members are not responsible for loss or damage to any portable article left in the Cemetery.

Removal

The Cemetery reserves the right to remove any markers found to be in contravention to these regulations.

Thickness of Flat Markers

Heights and Thickness

Monuments between 32" and 40" must be at least 7" thick. Monuments between 40" and 55" must be at

least 8" thick. reasons.

Footstones

Member's approval.

Type of Material

constructed solely of natural stone or bronze.

Inscriptions

No inscription shall be placed on any marker which is not in keeping with the dignity and decorum of the Cemetery.

Flowers

placed at the corner of the marker.

Fresh flowers and smaller pots may be placed on a grave one week prior and one week after Decoration Day, however, the Cemetery assumes no responsibility and will remove these and the containers when they become unsightly.

General

Trees and Shrubs


Trees and shrubs and decorations in the Cemetery must meet the approval of the Board Members. The Cemetery reserves the right to remove any that are not approved and prune any that grow too large.


Animals Prohibited
