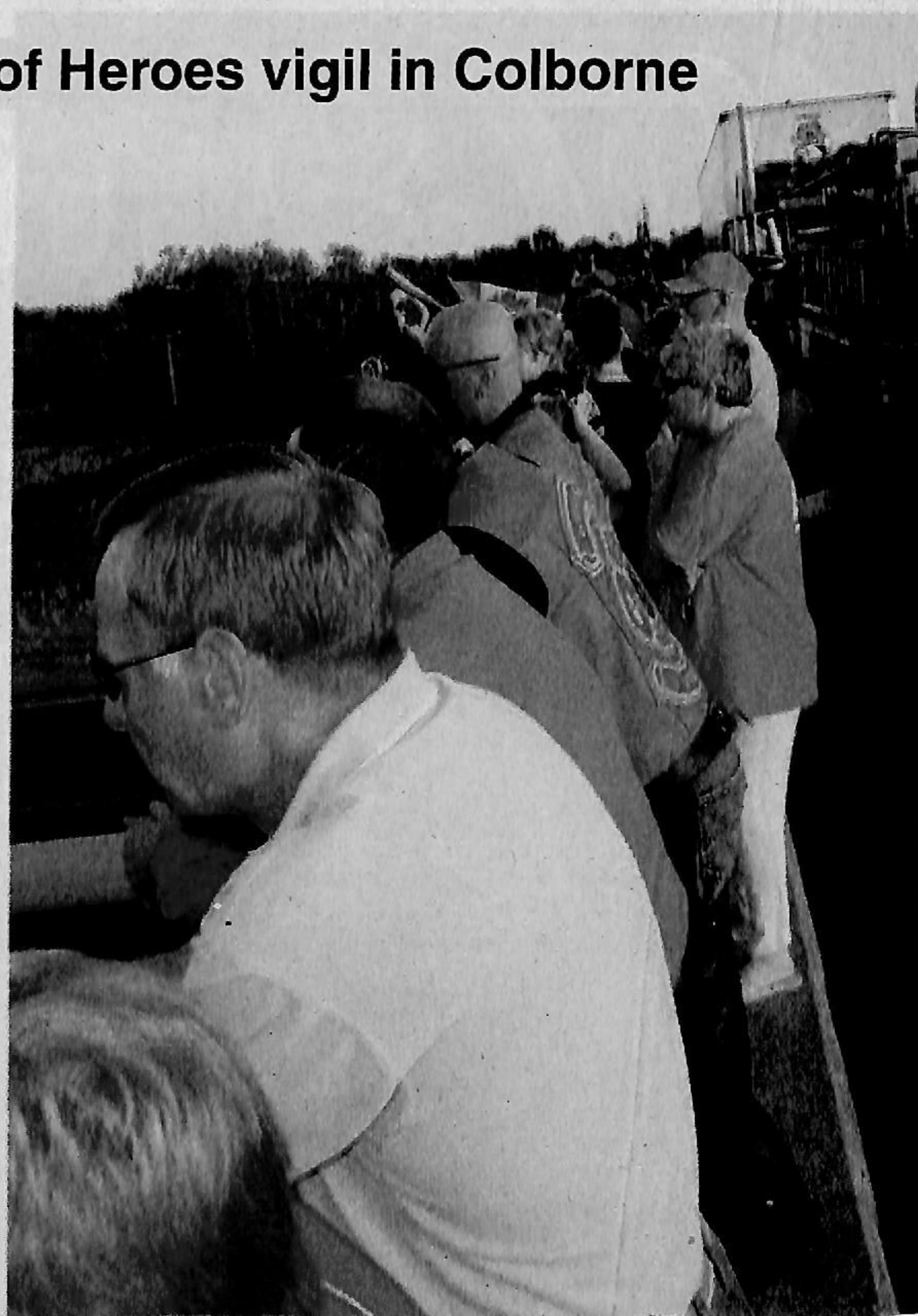

## Highway of Heroes vigil in Colborne

All along the Highway of Heroes route from Trenton to Toronto, Canadians gathered to pay tribute to three fallen Canadian soldiers and their families Sat. evening, Aug. 23. In Colborne, Larry Josie, above, brought his Poppy Truck to participate. from Edmonton, Alberta returned home to Canada today. The flight bearing the bodies of the soldiers arrived at 8 Wing, Canadian Forces Base Trenton at 6: p.m. Saturday. Present to pay their respects were Her Excellency The Governor General of Canada, The Right Honourable Michaëlle Jean, Minister of National Defence, The Honourable Peter MacKay, Chief of Defence Staff, General Walt Natynczyk and other dignitaries. The three soldiers were killed when an improvised explosive device detonated near their vehicle, while on patrol, around 10:30 a.m. Kandahar time Aug. 20.
