The proposed consent is for the creation of a new lot, identified as a "correction of title."

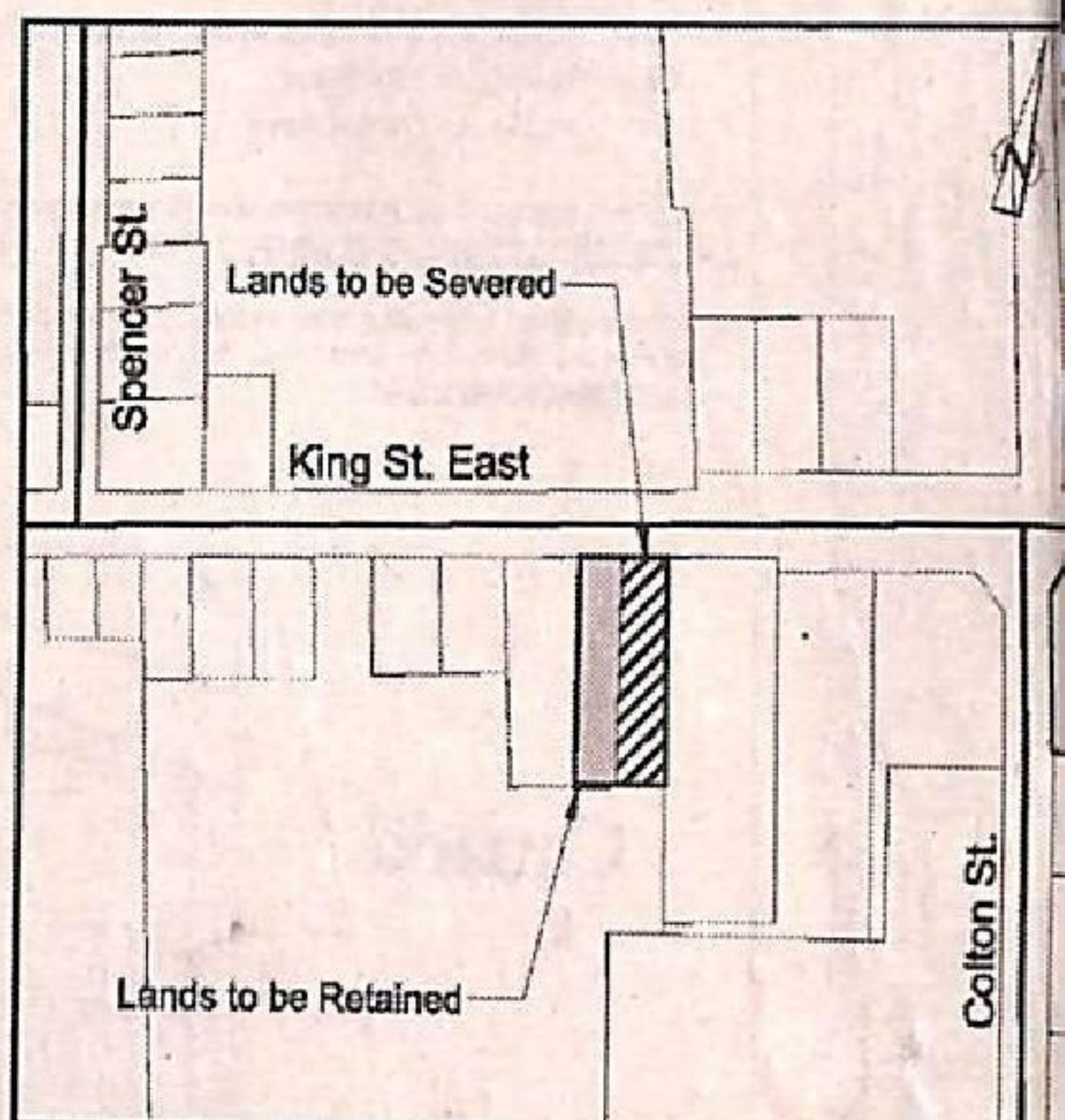
**WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS**

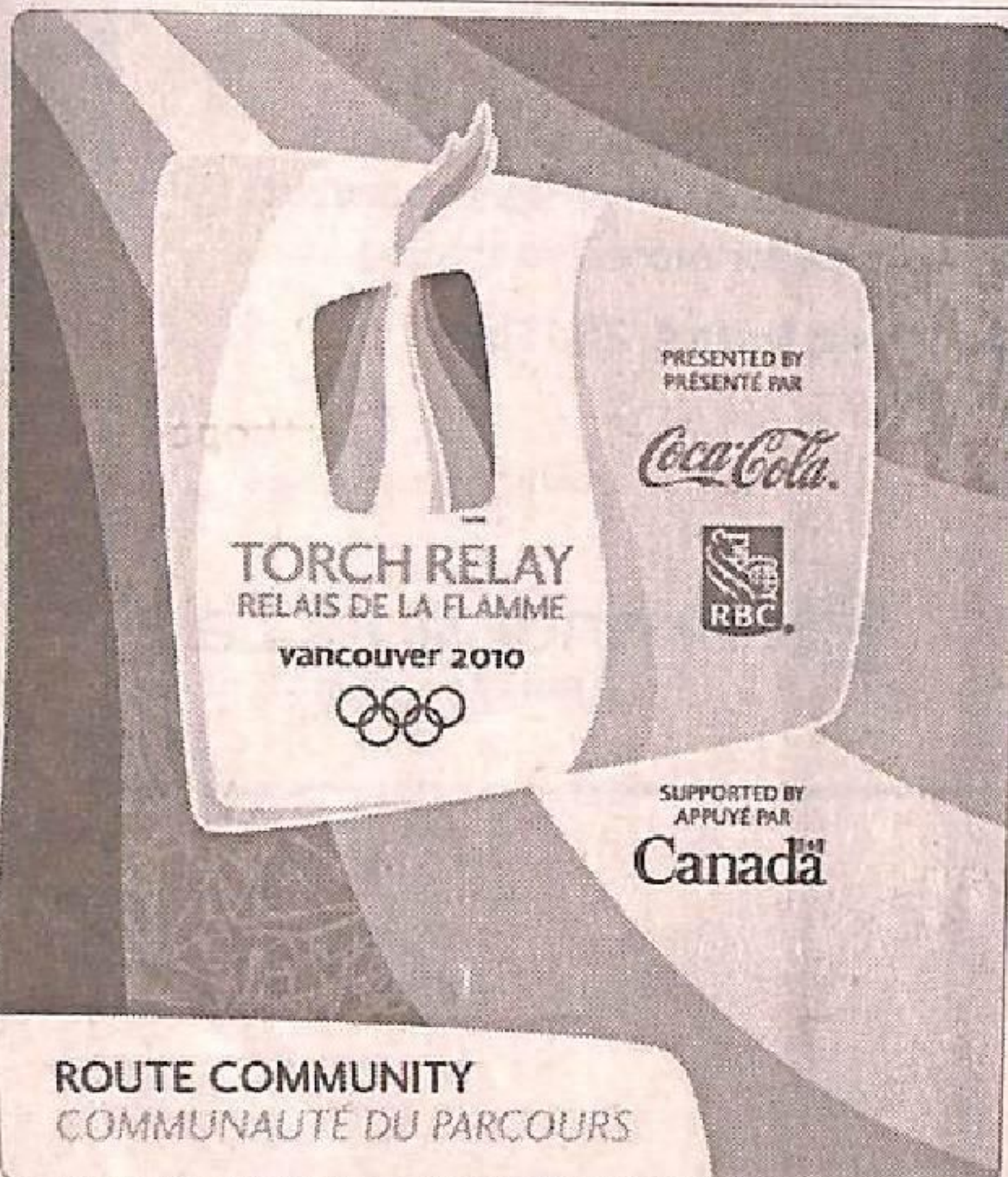

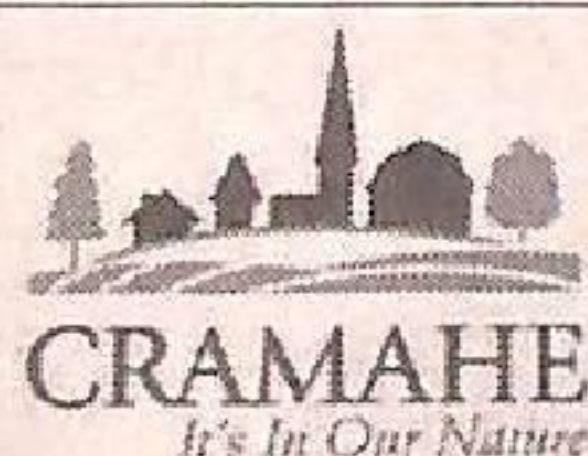
