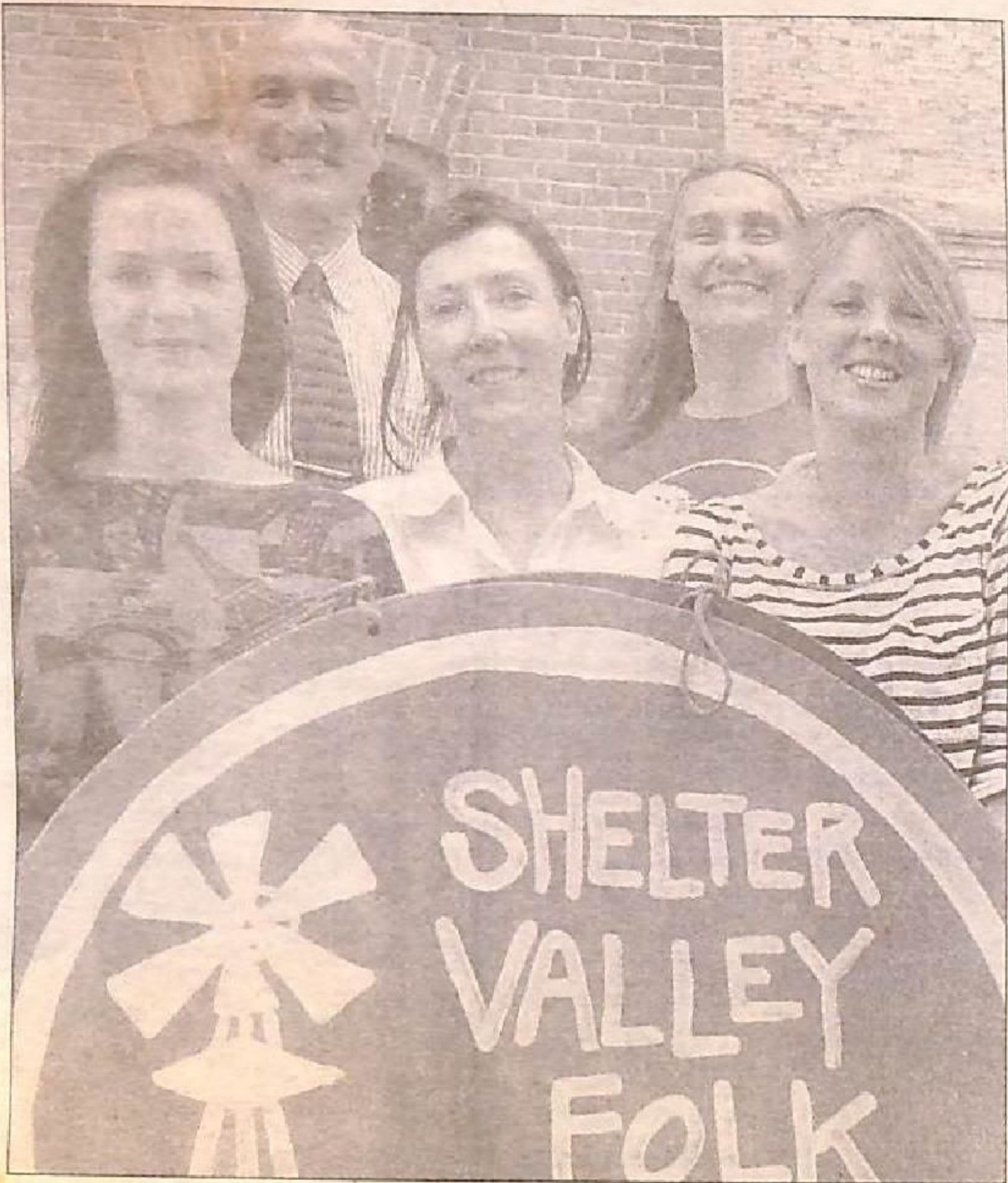


Shelter Valley Folk Festival gets federal funding

NORTHUMBERLAND -- The Shelter Valley Folk Festival received some good news this week.

Northumberland-Quinte West member of parliament Rick Norlock visited the Festival's new summer office in Cobourg's Firehall Theatre to deliver news of \$20,000 of funding from the Arts Presentation Canada Program through Canadian Heritage.

"The festival has built its reputation as a first class, family friendly and sustainable celebration of folk talent," said Mr. Norlock.

"It continues to attract visitors far beyond Northumberland County."

The news was met with obvious enthusiasm by festival executive director Jan Cody.

"The APCP support is wonderful and, along with our fundraising and ticket sales, makes all that we do year round in Northumberland possible," Ms. Cody said.

"It's a real support and comfort. Our MP has been there for us."

The seventh annual festival will take place on Labour Day weekend (Sept. 3-5) at Henkel Farm near Grafton.

The event will feature over 20 artists performing folk, roots and world music.

Also featured will be juried art, a wellness and sustainable living village and local harvest foods.
