Rodeo takes over Warkworth Fairgrounds

Warkworth had a western flavour last weekend.

The Warkworth Western Weekend was held July 3-4. The ever popular rodeo featured 250 cowboys competing in events such as calf roping, bull riding, barrel racing, mutton busting and steer wrestling.

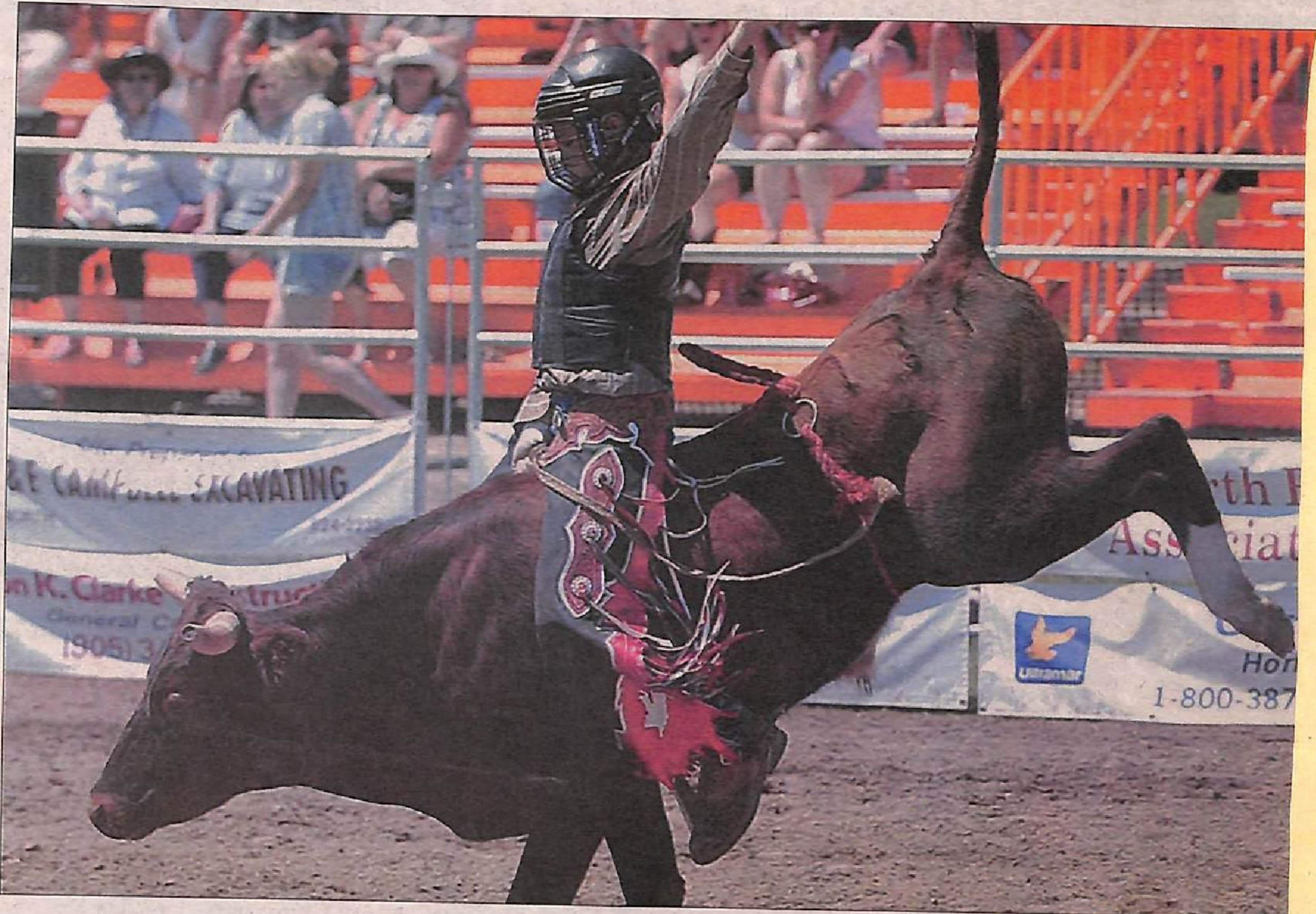
In calf roping, the cowboy ropes a fleeing calf from atop his horse.

Bull riding demands only that the cowboy stay atop his bucking ride for as long as he can. In team roping, two cowboys attempt to rope a steer.

Barrel racing is a horse race based on quickness and precision. In mutton busting, children under eight must stay atop a sheep for four seconds.

Steer wrestling calls for a cowboy to jump from his charging horse onto a running steer and wrestle it to the ground. In saddle bronc, riders must stay atop an untrained horse.
