For the construction of the works described below.

The work consists generally of the upgrade of the existing mechanical pollution control plant in Colborne with a new inlet communitor, new influent pumping system, demolition of existing mechanical aerators, installation of new fine bubble diffuser aeration system, blowers and appurtenances, clarifier mechanism replacement, effluent pumping station, effluent chlorination/dechlorination system, SCADA system, site works associated with existing lagoon segregation, yard piping, electrical and mechanical building upgrades and servicing.

On the same day, commencing at 11:15 A.M., local time, the tenders will be opened and read publicly by the Tender Committee in the Council Chamber at the above-mentioned address. Complete Tender documents may be obtained from the Kingston and Guelph Office of GENIVAR Inc., commencing at noon on Monday April 4, 2011 upon payment of a non-refundable Certified cheque in the amount of \$169.50 (\$150.00 plus \$19.50 HST) per contract set, payable to "GENIVAR Inc.". Each tender must be accompanied by a tender deposit in the form of a Certified cheque or bid bond in the amount of Ten (10%) percent of the total tendered amount payable to the "Township of Cramahé". Tenders are subject to a formal contract being prepared and executed and the receipt of a Certificate of Approval from the Ontario Ministry of Environment.
