It is not known what will happen to the property.

A closing service will be held and the chruch will be deconsecrated within 90 days of Easter Sunday. It will then be subeject to municipal taxes.

Church members do not even know the status of objects which are now in the building and have been contributed by its members. It is within the realm of possibility that the church might knock down the building, move the priest's grave on the front lawn and sell off the non-cemetery portions as building lots. The land cannot be sold with the graves.
