Ms. Park noted that the twp. debt-to-liabilities ratio is good. Current long-term debt stands at \$3 million.

Capital assets jumped by almost 15% to over \$20 million, with the work being done on the waste water treatment plant and upgrades at the Keeler Centre.

Cramahe contracted out \$1.5 million in services in 2011. Almost two-thirds went to the OPP for policing. Another quarter million was doled out on the waste water treatment expansion. The Transportation Department spent over \$126,000, and the Planning and Development Department spent \$80 thousand on consultants last year.
