"It was consecrated by Bishop Strachan in 1846 — well before the Toronto Diocese that intends to close it down was even established. Since that moment, it has been lovingly maintained by its parishioners. "

"Trinity Anglican Church has a marvellous Williams tracker pipe organ — there is only one other like it in North America — and important and valuable stained glass windows, some of which were donated as memorials to loved ones by Colborne and Cramahe families as stated on the windows in question. These could become the property of the Diocese in spite of their importance to Cramahe."

The vernacular Gothic Revival architecture of the church "could be vacated, abandoned, boarded up or even torn down" if the church is deconsecrated undesignated.
